Definitions of Classes

- **Girls/Boys/Ladies/Gentlemen's**

A Girls/Ladies horse or pony is a petite horse or pony that is not too forward or bold for a female rider.

A Boys/Gentlemen's horse or pony is a horse or pony that is more bold and forward – suitable to a Boys/Gentlemen's figure/ability.

- **Maiden Rider**

A rider that has not won a 1st at any event.

- **Maiden Galloway/Hack/Pony**

A horse/pony that has not won a 1st at any event.

- **Childs Hunter**

A child's Hunter pony is a pony suitable to a rider that is able to go forward without being too strong.

- **Kindergarten Class**

The combinations entered in this class are being asked to show their independence. The judge may ask for canter.

- **Trickster Classes**

Around-the-world, vaulting, no-stirrups, one handed etc.

May have assistance from an adult over 18 years to aid a safe and approved practice

- **Pleasure Pony**

May be asked to perform a simple task to prove the pony a fun and safe ride.
