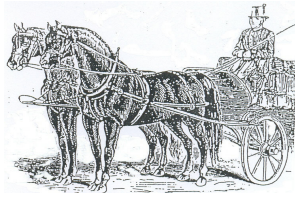

*Murray Districts Carriage Driving Club invites you to step back in time and dress in the period circa 1800-1910. All competitors and helpers are encouraged to dress in the period circa 1800-1910, and you will note there is a period costume class.*

*A Concours D Elegance is also included in the Schedule of Events and period costume will be accepted in this class. You will not be judged any differently if you are not dressed in period costume.*

*Judge's Resume - Jackie Boyd grew up with driving horses in the UK where her father was a professional coachman for over 40 years.*

*Jackie has driven in Australia for the past 25 years in combined driving and showing, competing in South Australia and interstate regularly during that time. Jackie has driven three different hackney horse pairs as well as a tandem over the past 15 years all competitively and successfully. She also had a scurry pair for a few seasons which she says was a lot of fun. Jackie is currently bringing on a novice horse, as well as a hackney horse/pony and enjoys the show circuit, combined driving as well as bringing on young horses. Jackie holds a EA Level 1 Coaching Certificate and is also an accredited ACSI Judge.*

### *Definitions*

**Maiden** – Exhibits not having placed First in any open harness horse/pony class ie height, weight, sulky, buggy. Turnout classes not included.

**Novice** – Exhibits not to have won more than 4 First places in any open horse/pony class ie height, weight, sulky, buggy, turnouts, whips, CDE classes not included.

**Authentic** – Antique, Vintage or Veteran vehicles – must be more than 50 years old. – Wooden wheels.

**Authentic Type** – Any, modern reproduction of Antique, Vintage or Veteran vehicle.

**Show Box Wagon or Viceroy** – Single seated show vehicle with 4 pneumatic wheels.

**CDE Turnout** – as for CDE Presentation/Dressage competition

**Pleasure Turnout** – Should be equipped with suitable items for a pleasure drive ie. Picnic basket etc.

**Pleasure Classes** – This is a relaxed, even-paced animal at both the trot and walk. Horse/pony should also stand in a relaxed manner.

**Period Costume** – Dress of driver and passenger/s should depict fashions of 1800 – 1910. Costume only to be judged.

**Concours D'Elegance** – The most elegant or eye-catching turnout. Period costume will be accepted in this class.

**Please check Show Driving Handbook for further details.**

**No dogs at this event, please. Competitors are asked to clean up and take away all hay, manure and rubbish.**

**Please don't forget to bring your own water for the horse/pony.**

**Venue:** Dwellingup Town Oval, McLarty St, Dwellingup

**Entry Fees:** \$10.00 per class or \$70.00 for the day

**Eligibility:** Competitors must be a financial member of the Australian Carriage Driving Society or non-members may apply for a One Day Activity Membership at a cost of \$25 – ODA forms available from the organisers.

1. The organisers DO NOT accept responsibility for loss or damage to horses, harness or vehicles, owners, drivers, passengers, spectators or any other persons or property whilst at or near the venue of this event.
2. Height certificates may be requested for those animals competing in classes with height stipulations.
3. Blinkers – all driven animals to wear blinkers whilst in harness.
4. Protests to be submitted in writing to the Ground Jury within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the class, accompanied by \$50 (non-refundable if protest is dismissed by the Ground Jury). The decision by the Ground Jury is final.
5. Junior drivers aged 6 – 10 years to be accompanied by an adult ACDS member holding a second set of reins.
6. Junior drivers aged 11 – 15 years must be accompanied by an experienced ACDS driver.
7. Multiple drivers aged 16 – 17 years may drive a pair of ponies but not horses or a big combination.
8. Stallions – Drivers under 16 years are not permitted to drive stallions. Drivers who are 16 – 17 years may drive a stallion at the discretion of the organising committee.
9. All junior drivers must wear an accredited helmet when either a driver or a passenger in a vehicle.
10. It is recommended that all entries have a suitably attired handler/groom in the line up whilst in the show ring.
11. Murray Districts Carriage Driving Club Inc. reserves the right to alter or amend this programme in any way it sees fit without giving prior notice.
12. Public Liability Insurance – Any person causing a claim to be made against the Australian Carriage Driving Society insurance policy is personally liable for the excess amount in full as determined by the Insurance Policy at the time of the incident.

1. (A) Ride & Drive – Open to Ponies and Horses (RIDDEN SECTION)

### **TURNOUTS**

2. Viceroy or Show Box Wagon Turnout – Horse or Pony
3. Authentic Turnout, Vintage, Veteran or Antique – Horse or Pony
4. Authentic Type, Reproduction Turnout – Horse or Pony
5. Pleasure Turnout – Horse or Pony

**CHAMPION/RESERVE TURNOUT – Classes 1 – 4**

**Garland for Champion Turnout**

**SPECIAL OPEN CLASS - BEST EQUIPT AWARD** – This class will be judged after the Champion Turnout. Competitors will need to show the Judge the accoutrements that you have in your chosen task. For example if you were on your way to church, you would have a bible, coins etc.

8. Period Costume – Circa 1800 – 1910 \*\* (any type of vehicle permitted)

12. Horse over 14 hands up to & including 15 hands
13. Horse over 15 hands
14. Lightweight pony 14 hands & under
15. Medium/heavyweight pony 14 hands & under
16. Lightweight horse over 14 hands
17. Medium/heavyweight horse over 14 hands

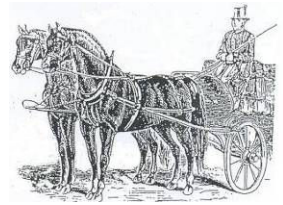
