Mandatory helper fee of \$ 40.00 per rider, fully refundable when helper job is completed. If helper fee not paid entry will not be accepted. Self help available. If you really do not wish to help you may pay the \$40.00. Start levy of \$2.50 per round to a maximum of \$15.00 for 6 rounds or more for the day. If you are not an EWA member then a ground fee is payable of \$15.00 per horse/pony per day. This applies to Pony Club & WASJA members who are not members of EWA. PCAWA members may ride in ring 2 in PC uniform and are subject to a gear check. PCAWA members who wish to be eligible for the highest placed Pony Club rider must ride in PCAWA uniform. Maximum of 2 rounds per horse & rider combination per day in ring 1. Maximum of 3 rounds per horse and rider combination per day in ring 2

Stallions can only be ridden by persons 16 years and over and must display a green disc at all times. Stallions may not be ridden by PCAWA members.

Yards available free of charge at Swan Valley Pony Club. Stables to be booked directly with the State Equestrian Centre

Entries close Sunday 16th September 9.00 pm. Entries on the day \$7.00 extra per class

Conditions of entry for Equineworld stakes qualifier #2

Horse rider combination not competed at a start height greater than 1.30m in 12 months prior to 1/1/2012. Rider must own or lease the horse.

Must be regular rider horse combination. Rider not competed in a world cup in the previous two years. Rider not competed in WEG or Olympics.

Riders must be 21 years or older and not eligible for Young Rider classes. Final in October 2012
