It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor/Owner to abide by all rules set out here and in associated documentation.

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| 1. | ASSOCIATION LIABILITY - The Western Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc (WAAHA Inc) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising. |
| 2. | SHOW RULES - This show is for Arabian and Arabian Derivatives and is governed by the current Arabian Horse Society of Australia Rule Book, EWA, and the SEC Rules and Regulations where no specific show rule is available. It is the responsibility of the entrant to read and be familiar with the rules. The current AHSA Rule book is available online at www.waaha.com.au or www.ahsa.asn.au . ** Competitors CANNOT be in contact with judges prior to competing. |
| 3. | SEC RULES - Any persons entering the stable area does so at their own risk and EWA and WAAHA Inc will not be held liable for any injury which may occur to riders, horses and general public. Under no circumstances may horses be tacked or tied up in the aisles. Smoking is only permitted on the entrance road side of the main SEC pavilion – smoking will not be tolerated or accepted in any other area. No alcohol may be brought into the Centre. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER STABLES OR MARSHALLING AREA WITH PRAMS AND/OR SMALL CHILDREN. UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN ARE ALSO NOT PERMITTED IN THESE AREAS. |
| 4. | MEMBER'S RATES - Only current (2019) Junior, General, Family/Joint and Life members of the WAAHA Inc whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter at WAAHA members rates. Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries. Non-members of WAAHA (Inc.) competing in Rider/Handler classes MUST pay non-member rates for those classes regardless of the horse owners' membership status. |
| 5. | ENTRIES – All entries must be made in the name of the registered owner/lessee of the exhibit. Entries can be submitted online via nominate.com.au , via post or via email and must be accompanied by the correct payment and all supporting documents. No refund or credit of entries will be made after the closing date of entries. A payment plan may be used, but full payment must be made by close of entries. Incorrect and/or incomplete entries that have not been finalised by close of entries will incur an additional \$25 penalty fee. This may mean your entry is NOT listed in the catalogue. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> By lodging an entry the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms & conditions set out herein. The signature of an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same. Owners of ALL Purebreds and Derivatives must be CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF AHSA to enter their horse(s) at this show. Horses without a registration number cannot be exhibited. All horses must be able to be identified by their brands and/or markings in accordance with the Certificate of Registration issued by the Society. Exhibitors must include the names of handlers and riders on their entry – if not listed on the competitor declaration form they will not be permitted to enter the ring. All handlers and riders entering the ring MUST be a member of either WAAHA, AHSA, EWA or have their own insurance cover. The WAAHA Inc Committee reserves the right to conditionally refuse, cancel or accept any entry. ALL OWNERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF THEIR PAPERWORK WITH THEM AT THE SHOW. |
| 6. | GROUND FEES - Are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members and MUST be paid with the entry. Proof of current EWA membership to be supplied with entry. SEC Levy must be paid for every horse. |
| 7. | REGISTERED PARTICIPANT FEE - There will be no more Day Registered Participants at AHSA and AHSA Affiliate Events. Every participant at an Arabian event must either be an AHSA Member or an AHSA Affiliate Member. AHSA Members will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. A new annual Participation Membership category within the Society's Direct Membership is now available for handlers, riders, strappers etc. to participate. This membership is for Insurance purposes only. Participant Membership will cost \$30.00 and the Participant Member will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. Any AHSA membership DOES NOT qualify you for WAAHA membership rates. |
| 8. | CONDUCT - Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Officials and fellow competitors. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the Show. | 10. | <p>EXHIBIT NUMBERS - Exhibit numbers must be worn on the back of the handler/rider, around the horse's neck or on the horse's nearside in the case of costume/fancy dress classes. Competitors must not enter any class without their correct exhibit number displayed.</p> |
| 11. | <p>LAMENESS - Horses exhibiting any sign of serious lameness in the opinion of the Judge and/or the WAAHA committee will be excused from the class and take no further part in competition for the remainder of the day. THIS IS AN ANIMAL WELFARE ISSUE. Whip and/or Spur abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.</p> |
| 12. | <p>SWABBING - Any exhibit may be swabbed for prohibited substances. Results of swabs taken will be published. Horses returning a positive swab will be subject to penalties as per current AHSA Ltd Rule Book. A copy of registration certificates must be available on the day.</p> |
| 13. | <p>STABLING AND CAMPING - Camping fees are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members. Stable fees are applicable to everyone. Please note that all stables and camp sites are to be booked as per instructions on the SEC website http://www.secbrigadoon.com/. DO NOT SEND THESE FORMS OR FEES TO WAAHA.</p> |
| 14. | <p>PROTESTS - All protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of a class being completed, be submitted in writing, and be made with a \$100 payment. The judge MAY NOT be approached by any competitor. The judge's and/or organizing committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. If the protest is upheld, the \$100 lodgment- fee will be refunded.</p> |
| 15. | <p>NON-PROFESSIONAL CLASSES - Competitors in these classes must supply a declaration claiming non-professional status at each show. A copy of the declaration must be provided with your entry. No proof = no entry.</p> |
| 16. | <p>HALF ARABIAN - Half Arabian classes are for those registered in the Half Arabian registry of the AHSA. Half Arabians competing in Half Arabian classes will be judged on Arabian Type as well as conformation and movement.</p> |
| 17. | <p>ARABIAN PERFORMANCE INDEX - Arabian Performance Index recorded horses and ponies with AHSA, are eligible to compete in any class not specified for any particular Arabian Derivative registry. They are not eligible to compete in classes listed as being restricted to Purebred Arabians, Half Arabians, Partbred Arabians, Arabian Ponies, Arabian Riding Ponies, Anglo Arabians, Arabian Warmbloods, Arabian Stock Horses or Quarabs or those classes with Registered Derivative in their title. They may be used in Junior Handler classes, Lead Line etc. <i>API are eligible for the following classes only: 1-3,6,7,9,10,13-20,30,52,53,56-59,99-101,104-107, 109</i></p> |
| 18. | <p>LEAD LINE CLASSES – Youth riding in Leadline rider class CANNOT also compete in classes 17 or 18</p> |
| 19. | <p>WA BORN AND BRED - Exhibits resulting from a mating in WA, with the Dam resident in WA and the resulting progeny being foaled in WA. Foals born as a result of an AI mating to a Stallion not resident in WA are eligible. (Proof of place of AI may be required)</p> |
| 20. | <p>NON WA BRED – Open to any exhibit NOT eligible for WA born and bred</p> |
| 21. | <p>YOUNG SADDLE HORSE CLASSES - must be ridden in a snaffle bit.</p> |
| 22. | <p>OPEN DRESSAGE COMPETITION – Must be entered on separate event entry form.</p> |
| 23. | <p>WEST COAST CUP - Exhibits competing in these classes are to be presented and judged as Open Hacks. All horses must be plaited. Rider to be correctly dressed in Formal English riding attire (including gloves), dressage whips are not permitted. Riders may ride a maximum of 2 horses in each class, however all horses must have a suitably attired and capable rider at all times. No horses are to be presented before the judge unmounted. The Top 5 will be selected by the judge/s, awarded their rosettes, and the winner and runner-up drawn from this Top 5. The Top 5 all receive prize money (25% of entry fees to winner, 10% to runner-up, and 5% to remaining Top 5 horse). All remaining competitors will receive a sash.</p> |

LIBERTY: SEE AHSA RULE 26 ** There must be at least 5 entries, or the class sponsored, to be run.

The purpose of this event is to see the Arabian horse in all its glory. The emphasis is on movement, especially at the trot, as the Judge considers the overall balance and proportion of the exhibit, tail carriage and length of stride, use of arena. At the Trot we are looking for free swinging movement with forelegs extended well forward from the shoulder, the feet dwelling for a moment at full stretch before contacting the ground, exhibiting the characteristic floating action. There should be a matching free forward swing of the limbs from the shoulders and the stifles, with the knees and hocks being well flexed and hind legs brought well forward under the body. A display of other paces is acceptable. It is recommended that the Judging time for this event be two (2) minutes, with up to one (1) minute catching time. A suitable and safe catching area must be provided.

25.1 Horses must be 2yrs and over

25.2 The use of whips and shakers should be in moderation.

25.3 No more than 3 handlers be present in the arena at one time.

25.4 A safe and suitably sized Arena with particular attention being given to the fencing shall be used.

25.5 The work area is to be marked into 3 zones or for arenas smaller than 20m x 40m- 2 zones – one at each end max ¼ of arena (Middle area 2/4) or in the case of a smaller arena a zone at one end of the arena.

25.6 One handler only per area at all times during the 2 min performance.

25.7 Handlers must 16yr & over or 18yr & over if showing a stallion or colt.

25.8 Audience participation is encouraged in the way of clapping and cheering however the use of other aids such as shakers, bins etc is not encouraged. This should be clearly conveyed to the audience prior and if necessary during the event by the announcer and if necessary the Ring Master.

25.9 The performance can be halted at any time as the well being of the horse is of paramount importance and horses should not show any sign of stress

25.10 Event organisers MUST have a competent Ring Master that will be responsible for the running of the class.

25.11 If the horse becomes stressed and continually runs to the gate it is the responsibility of the Ring Master to having the music stopped and horse caught. In this case there will be a NO SCORE.

25.12 The announcer/music controller to work closely with the Ring Master so music can be stopped at any time as instructed by the Ring Master.

The Top 5 all receive prize money (25% of entry fees to winner, 10% to runner up, and 5% to remaining Top 5)

All remaining competitors will receive a sash.
