CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all competitors, whether actually engaged in any event or not, do so at their own risk and will indemnify and save harmless the organizing club, committee members and members from all claims, actions, suits or demands arising out of injury, personal or otherwise caused out of their presence at this show. **Disclaimer Statement forms to be completed and sent back with prepaid entries.**

The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner.

The committee reserves the right to alter the program without prior notice. Strictly no refunds will be issued.

ASA approved hard hats must be worn at all times, whilst mounted.

Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced.

Stallions are to be bitted at all times and must be under the supervision of a person over 18 years of age. The Judge's decision is final.

Ridden Classes:

Horses/riders that are placed 1st in their classes are to present for the judging of the Championship and Reserve Championship awards. Any rider that comes 2nd to the Champion is eligible to contest for Reserve Champion.

Presentation:

All ridden horses must be plaited. For halter, stallions may be left with a free flowing mane and tail. All horses must be neat and clean and no paddock halters or lead ropes are allowed.

Handler -

- Halter Neat pants (no jeans allowed) and dress shirt. Jacket, hat and gloves are recommended but optional. Suitable footwear (no joggers/open shoes/ballet flats) must be worn. Whip optional for mares and geldings but compulsory for colts and stallions.
- Ridden Jodhpurs, shirt, tie or stock, jacket, riding boots and approved helmet. Whip or crop
 optional. Junior rider class riders must wear short boots.
- Harness Horses must compete in race sulky only. No hopple, boots, head checks, tail ties and earplugs as per Rules set down by Carriage Association. Block blinkers must be worn for insurance purposes. Drivers to wear attire as for halter.

Ridden Classifications & Rulings

If your horse is not listed below in the SPPHAWA Ridden Assessment list it is deemed an Elementary Horse. Alternatively you may decide to not compete in the elementary classes and take the option to earn points by competing in the Intermediate or Open classes. You will be required to do set workouts and canter on both reins with advanced transitions. If you have any queries please contact Kristie.

Elementary Hack classes (Walk & Trot) – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. If competing in this section you cannot compete in the Intermediate/Open classes. Once you compete in any 'canter' class you will no longer be eligible for these classes.

Intermediate Hack (SPPHAWA Grading) – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. Horses will earn points for the Intermediate Hack awards only. This section still requires canter but you are not competing against Open horses. If competing in Intermediate classes you can also compete in the Open Smartest on Parade and Rider classes but not in the Open Hack classes.

Show Horse/Show Hunter – You can only compete in one class not both. As it is only one class at this show you will be expected to work like a hunter however the full attire (plain browband/Jacket) is not compulsory.
