CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all competitors, whether actually engaged in any event or not, do so at their own risk and will indemnify and save harmless the organizing club, committee members and members from all claims, actions, suits or demands arising out of injury, personal or otherwise caused out of their presence at this show. **Disclaimer Statement forms to be completed and sent back with prepaid entries.**

The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner. The committee reserves the right to alter the program without prior notice. Strictly no refunds will be issued. ASA approved hard hats must be worn at all times, whilst mounted. Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced. Stallions are to be bitted at all times and must be under the supervision of a person over 18 years of age. The Judge's decision is final.

Presentation:

All ridden horses must be plaited. For halter, stallions & race conditioned horses may be left with a free flowing mane and tail. All horses must be neat and clean and no paddock halters or lead ropes are allowed. Handler:

- Halter Neat pants (no jeans allowed) and dress shirt. Jacket, hat and gloves are essential for a presentation class but optional for all others. If dresses are worn shoulders should be covered, they must be knee length and enable the handler to run easily. Suitable footwear (no joggers/open shoes/ballet flats) must be worn and need to cover at least half of the top of the foot. Whip optional for mares and geldings but compulsory for colts and stallions.
- o Ridden Jodhpurs, shirt, tie or stock, jacket, riding boots and approved helmet. Whip or crop optional. Junior rider class riders must wear short boots.
- Harness Horses must compete in race sulky only. No hopple, boots, head checks, tail ties and earplugs as per Rules set down by Carriage Association. Block blinkers must be worn for insurance purposes. Drivers to wear attire as for halter.

Ridden Classes:

Horses/riders that are placed 1st in their classes are to present for the judging of the Championship and Reserve Championship awards. Any rider that comes 2nd to the Champion is eligible to contest for Reserve Champion.

Ridden Classifications & Rulings

Elementary Hack classes (Walk & Trot) – These classes are for any horses who would like to compete in Walk/Trot and have not competed in a canter ring. If competing in this section you cannot compete in the Intermediate/Open classes. Once you compete in any 'open/canter' events (Including Dressage) you will no longer be eligible for these classes.

Intermediate Hack (SPPHAWA Grading) – These classes are for horses that have moved up from the Walk/Trot ring and any non-member who would like to compete at a canter. Member's horses will earn points for the Intermediate Hack awards only. This section requires canter however it is a transition section for horses to develop an established canter for the Open ring. If competing in Intermediate classes you can also compete in the Rider classes but not in the Open Hack classes.

Show Horse/Show Hunter – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses only. You can only compete in one section not both and will need to pick a section at your first event for the season and stay in that section for the duration of the season. Full Hunter attire is required if competing in the Show Hunter section.
