Separate awards will be made for purebreds, derivatives and open at each level. Every effort will be made to avoid draw clashes with halter classes – judge will remain 30 mins after the final tests in the draw – it is the rider's responsibility to complete their tests before the 30 minutes has passed.

Rules and Conditions of Entry for the 2019 WAAHA All Arabian Show

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor/Owner to abide by all rules set out here and in associated documentation.

1.	<p>ASSOCIATION LIABILITY - The Western Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc (WAAHA Inc) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising.</p>
2.	<p>SHOW RULES - This show is for Arabian and Arabian Derivatives and is governed by the current Arabian Horse Society of Australia Rule Book, EWA, and the SEC Rules and Regulations where no specific show rule is available. It is the responsibility of the entrant to read and be familiar with the rules. The current AHSA Rule book is available online at www.waaha.com.au or www.ahsa.asn.au.</p>
3.	<p>SEC RULES - Any persons entering the stable area does so at their own risk and EWA and WAAHA Inc will not be held liable for any injury which may occur to riders, horses and general public. Under no circumstances may horses be tacked or tied up in the aisles. Smoking is only permitted on the entrance road side of the main SEC pavilion – smoking will not be tolerated or accepted in any other area. No alcohol may be brought into the Centre. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER STABLES OR MARSHALLING AREA WITH PRAMS AND/OR SMALL CHILDREN. UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN ARE ALSO NOT PERMITTED IN THESE AREAS.</p>
4.	<p>STABLING AND CAMPING - Camping fees are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members. Stable fees are applicable to everyone. Please note that all stables and camp sites are to be booked as per instructions on the SEC website http://www.secbrigadoon.com/. DO NOT SEND THESE FORMS OR FEES TO WAAHA.</p>
5.	<p>GROUND FEES - Are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members and MUST be paid with the entry. Proof of current EWA membership to be supplied with entry. SEC Levy must be paid by all competitors.</p>
6.	<p>MEMBER'S RATES - Only current (2019) Junior, General, Family/Joint and Life members of the WAAHA Inc whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter at WAAHA members rates. Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries. Non-members of WAAHA (Inc.) competing in Rider/Handler classes MUST pay non-member rates for those classes regardless of the horse owners' membership status.</p>
7.	<p>ENTRIES – All entries must be made in the name of the registered owner/lessee of the exhibit. Entries can be submitted via post or via email and must be accompanied by the correct payment or proof of payment, and all supporting documents. No refund or credit of entries will be made after the closing date of entries. A payment plan may be used, but full payment must be made by close of entries. Incorrect and/or incomplete entries that have not been finalised by close of entries will incur an additional \$25 penalty fee. This may mean your entry is NOT listed in the catalogue.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • By lodging an entry the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms & conditions set out herein. The signature of an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same. • Owners of ALL Purebreds and Derivatives must be CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF AHSA to enter their horse(s) at this show. • Horses without a registration number cannot be exhibited. • All horses must be able to be identified by their brands and/or markings in accordance with the Certificate of Registration issued by the Society. • Exhibitors must include the names of handlers and riders on their entry – if not listed on the competitor declaration form they will not be permitted to enter the ring. • All handlers and riders entering the ring MUST be a member of either, WAAHA, AHSA, EWA or have proof of their own insurance cover. • The WAAHA Inc Committee reserves the right to conditionally refuse, cancel or accept any entry. <p style="text-align: center;">ALL OWNERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF THEIR PAPERWORK WITH THEM AT THE SHOW.</p>
8.	<p>EXHIBIT NUMBERS - Exhibit numbers must be worn on the back of the handler/rider, around the horse's neck or on the horse's nearside in the case of costume/fancy dress classes. Competitors must not enter any class without their correct exhibit number displayed.</p>

9.	<p>REGISTERED PARTICIPANT FEE - There will be no more Day Registered Participants at AHSA and AHSA Affiliate Events. Every participant at an Arabian event must either be an AHSA Member or an AHSA Affiliate Member. AHSA Members will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance.</p> <p>A new annual Participation Membership category within the Society's Direct Membership is now available for handlers, riders, strappers etc. to participate. This membership is for Insurance purposes only. Participant Membership will cost \$30.00 and the Participant Member will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. Any AHSA membership DOES NOT qualify you for WAAHA membership rates.</p>
10.	<p>SWABBING - Any exhibit may be swabbed for prohibited substances. Results of swabs taken will be published. Horses returning a positive swab will be subject to penalties as per current AHSA Ltd Rule Book. A copy of registration certificates must be available on the day.</p>
11.	<p>SHOW COMMITTEE shall have the power, without assigning any reason to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Reject or cancel any entry at any time. b) Prohibit the participation by any person or exhibit in any event or class for which it is entered. c) Cancel, combine or divide any event or class. d) Alter the time at which any class or event is to take place. e) Order the removal of any exhibit from the Show grounds. f) Transfer an exhibit from any class to any other class. g) Act upon any report of cruelty to any exhibit on the Showground. Clauses b) and e) above may be invoked. h) Enforce the exclusion of any exhibit which has been excused from any class upon the direction of a Judge
12.	<p>CONDUCT - Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Officials and fellow competitors. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the Show. Please refer to the current AHSA Ltd Rule Book for information. BULLYING OF ANY DESCRIPTION WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.</p>
13.	<p>LAMENESS - Horses exhibiting any sign of serious lameness in the opinion of the Judge and/or the WAAHA committee will be excused from the class and take no further part in competition for the remainder of the day. THIS IS AN ANIMAL WELFARE ISSUE. Whip and/or Spur abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.</p>
14.	<p>NON-PROFESSIONAL CLASSES - Competitors in these classes must supply a declaration claiming non-professional status. A copy of the declaration must be provided with your entry. No proof = no entry.</p>
15.	<p>DRESSAGE - Where dressage classes are offered, all tests will be run in accordance with the current EA dressage rules if no show specific rules exist. Horses must not compete below their official graded level or at more than two consecutive levels. No horse may compete in more than two tests. Only one rider per horse is permitted in dressage. Draw will be emailed to competitors.</p>
16.	<p>LEAD LINE – Youth riding in Lead line rider classes CANNOT also compete in classes 55 or 179</p>
17.	<p>WA BRED - are for exhibits resulting from a mating in WA, with the Dam resident in WA and the resulting progeny being foaled in WA. Foals born as a result of an AI mating to a Stallion not resident in WA are eligible providing the mating occurred in WA (Proof of place of AI may be required)</p>
18.	<p>ARABIAN PERFORMANCE INDEX - Arabian Performance Index recorded horses and ponies with AHSA, are eligible to compete in any class not specified for any particular Arabian Derivative registry. They are not eligible to compete in classes listed as being restricted to Purebred Arabians, Half Arabians, Partbred Arabians, Arabian Ponies, Arabian Riding Ponies, Anglo Arabians, Arabian Warmbloods, Arabian Stock Horses or Quarabs or those classes with Derivative in their title. They may be used in Junior Handler classes, Lead Line etc. <i>API are eligible for the following classes only:117-124, 126, 128, 132-134, 141-144, 164-186</i></p>
19.	<p>HALF ARABIAN - Half Arabian classes are for those registered in the Half Arabian registry of the AHSA. Half Arabians competing in Half Arabian classes will be judged on Arabian Type as well as conformation and movement.</p>

20.	<p>NEWCOMER & YOUNG SADDLE HORSES - must be ridden in a snaffle bit. Newcomers must not have competed at any ridden event (with the exception of Racing/Endurance) under saddle prior to 22nd July 2018. A Pony that has only competed in Leading Rein and has not competed off the lead is eligible to be considered a Newcomer</p>
21.	<p>DUAL REGISTERED - Horses entering Dual registered classes MUST provide proof of dual registration, and must be shown under the name of the registered AHSA owner.</p>
22.	<p>BROOD MARE - Open to mares of ANY AGE. Eligible entries must meet the following minimum requirements and the onus is on the exhibitor to prove eligibility if required:</p> <p>a) Mare must have carried, delivered, nursed & weaned at least two (2) foals (embryo transfer foals will not count toward the total number of foals carried)</p> <p>b) If a Mare is nursing a foal the foal must be led and must accompany the mare at all times. The foal shall not be less than 4 weeks (28 days) of age and handled by a handler 18yrs and over.</p> <p>c) Any mare shown, MUST NOT be more than nine (9) months (275 days) in foal at the date of the show.</p> <p>d) If a mare more than 150 days in foal is to be shown, a Service Certificate or Pregnancy Certificate from a licensed veterinarian or reproductive technician must be available for inspection at the show by the Show Committee.</p> <p>e) Any eligible mare may show in the Broodmare class. A mare may compete in a brood mare or open mare class but not in both at the same show. – NO CROSS ENTRIES are permitted between the Broodmare class and the respective age divisions</p> <p>RIDDEN MARES with foals at foot Mares with foals at foot may be ridden in the applicable ridden mare class only. The mare WILL be excused from the class if the foal's presence or behavior interferes or distracts other mares in that class.</p>
23.	<p>HOY RIDDEN CLASSES - At the committee's discretion, classes that qualify for HOY 2019 MAY be held up to ensure all eligible horses have an equal opportunity to compete. A timetable will be issued and all efforts will be made to ensure other classes do not clash. However, non-HOY classes will NOT be held up for longer than 5 minutes, so competitors may need to choose.</p>
24.	<p>PROTESTS - All protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of a class being completed, be submitted in writing, and be made with a \$100 payment. The judge MAY NOT be approached by any competitor. The judge's and organizing committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. If the protest is upheld, the \$100 lodgment- fee will be refunded.</p>
25.	<p>SPORT HORSE CLASSES - Sport horse in hand is judging form to function conformation, without any apparent artifice. The horses are brought into the ring individually, and judged on their conformation and movement as it pertains to their ability to make a good performance horse. Each horse is scored on a score sheet; score sheets may be collected from the show office after results have been posted. There is a set workout, which will be emailed to competitors after close of entries.</p> <p>Horses 3 years & over are to be shown in a plain leather snaffle bridle.</p> <p>Horses 2 years & under must wear a leather stable halter or plain show halter.</p> <p>Horses 2 years may be shown in a plain leather snaffle bridle if preferred. <u>Make up is minimal.</u></p> <p>Upon being directed by the steward to enter the ring, each horse will walk straight towards the judge, halt and be stood in a more natural pose (lowered head and neck) than used in other Arabian in hand classes. An 'open stance' (ie all 4 legs visible from either side) may also be used. The judge will then direct the competitor to complete the set workout, walk a triangle, then trot a triangle, before halting again. The horse then leaves the ring via the exit. The workout and blank scoring sheet will be emailed to competitors after close of entries.</p> <p>Sport Horse saddle classes are judged on the circle at the walk, trot and canter. Lengthening of any gait may be required; a rein back whilst lined up may also be executed. <u>Horses are presented as if for a show hunter class - no bling browbands and minimal makeup.</u></p> <p>No scoring sheet is used for saddle classes.</p>

ULTIMATE CLASSES

- Qualification - a horse must compete and place in their breed halter and breed ridden classes to qualify to compete in the Ultimate class. A breed class is a mare, stallion or gelding class that is not restricted by handler or rider age or status.
- Judging – The class is conducted in two parts. In Part 1 exhibits are presented to the judge(s) in halter and each exhibit is given a score out of 10 (one being the lowest score and ten being the highest). In Part 2, exhibits are presented to the judge(s) under saddle where a ridden workout is completed and each exhibit is given an additional score out of 10.
- Scoring - The led and ridden Parts of the class are each worth 50%. The points from both parts of the class are combined and the highest score wins. Ties are split by the higher halter score.
- Presentation of winner - Horses to be saddled at the completion of the class for presentations. Places awarded will be gold, silver and bronze for first, second and third respectively.
- Judges – One or two judges may be used. If one judge is used (one judge for Part A and one judge for Part B) the score is out of 20, and if two are used (both judge Part A and Part B) the score is out of 40.
- Handler/Rider – there must only be one rider and one handler per horse. These may be the same person, or two people. There should be no more than two individuals in the ring at any one time.
- There is no restriction on the number of times an exhibit can win this class, provided that it enters and contests the class in accordance with the rules.
- *Committee reserves the right to modify the way this class is judged on the day if the situation dictates – e.g. cancellation of classes due to extreme weather, etc*

FASHIONS ON THE FIELD – open to both male and female handlers. It will be scored by both judges using the following criteria:

1. Appropriateness of outfit for the particular event (e.g. climate/weather)
2. Appropriateness of outfits for Fashions on the Field (e.g. appropriate length skirt, no excessive exposure of skin);
3. Style and originality;
4. Attention to detail including matching the horse (e.g. millinery, clutch, jewellery);
5. Grooming and deportment.

A second handler may be used to hold the horse. They must be appropriately dressed to not detract from the overalls picture but they will not be judged.

In the event of a tie, highest combined scores in section 4 shall take precedence.

Committee reserves the right to modify the way this class is judged on the day if the situation dictates – e.g. cancellation of classes due to extreme weather, etc.
