IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT STABLING

The RAS is only able to provide 120 stables per day, which unfortunately is well under the number of exhibits present each day of the show. To assist with the over subscription of stables the following protocol will be in place to ensure that all competitors are accommodated to the best of our ability. Priority parking will be made available to competitors that do not require stables to improve their access to the main arena.

Each exhibit is required to pay a compulsory ground fee of \$11 per day that the exhibit is competing. This fee will be calculated automatically with your entry. This does not automatically issue the exhibit with a stable.

To book stables you must select the number of stables you require each day of the show and pay \$5 per stable per day. Stables will **not** be available to exhibits that are not competing on a given day unless spare stables are available.

Stable bookings must also include if they are for a mare and foal, a colt or stallion or a large exhibit.

Stabling will be prioritised for mares with foals, colts/stallions, country exhibitors and exhibitors with a large number of exhibits.

Exhibitors that book stables but are unable to be allocated stables will have their stable fees refunded. All stabling requests must be emailed to allwelshstables@gmail.com, however, not all requests may be able to be met.
