AWHA LTD PLATINUM SASHES AWARDED ON THE DAY - FOR ALL FOALS / HORSES SCORING 85.00% AND ABOVE!

NOTE: in the event of a tie for any of the cash awards, the prize money for that placing will be divided by the number of place getters for that score. All place getters will receive sashes.

* **Please note**: all horses must be registered with the AWHA Ltd in the current owner's name. Owners must be current financial members of the AWHA Ltd. For foals and horses that are registration pending, please attach a copy of your registration application form.

* Please note: Entries for Foals and Horses that are AWHA Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the Federal AWHA Registrations Administrator ie; all required AWHA registration paperwork and payment must be submitted in advance of acceptance of the Tour entry for classes.

* Where applicable: foals shall be entered registration pending, inclusive of foals that are not yet born, by the closing date of Friday 8th February 2019.

MARE CLASSIFICATIONS: all Warmblood mares being classified on tour may also enter their relevant AWHA Ltd led class - noting that no discount applies to the Mare Classification fee or the National Championship entry fee. Any members wishing to have their mare classified during the 2019 AHWA National Championships Tour, should contact <u>Silvia Ahamer</u> or phone (02 4884 4143), prior to close of entries. All mares passing AWHA Ltd classification will be awarded a Sash on the day.

\$100 and Broad Sash for highest % Nationally for both led and ridden classes.

NOTE: in the event of a tie for any of the cash awards, the prize money for that placing will be divided by the number of place getters for that score. All place getters will receive sashes.

NOTE: classes are subject to horse entries. Three horse entries and under may result in a class being combined.

* Please note: all horses being assessed must be registered with their respective breed association in their current owner's name. Owners must be current financial members of their respective association. Please attach a copy of your horse/s registration papers and proof of membership to your entry form. For foals and horses that are registration pending, please attach a copy of your association's registration application form.

* Where applicable: foals shall be entered registration pending, inclusive of foals that are not yet born, by the closing date of Friday 8th February 2019. Please note: Entries for Foals and Horses that are Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the Federal AWHA Registrations Administrator.



All Warmblood horses competing in open classes must be registered with a breed association such as the AWHA Ltd, A.C.E. Group Inc., Hanoverian Horse Society of Australia (HHSA), Holsteiner Horse Association of Australia (HHAA), International Sporthorse Studbook Australia (ISSA) or Trakehners Australia Inc.

Please note: horses competing in Open classes must have a **minimum of 25% Warmblood breeding** in their pedigree. **Proof of registration is required with entry**.

AWHA Ltd members who have a horse/s participating in both the AWHA Ltd classes as well as the Open classes may elect to have their AWHA Ltd class score transferred as their Open class score. Alternatively, AWHA Ltd members may re-present their horse/s for the Open class and receive an additional score sheet and marks.

2019 AWHA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AND CLASSIFICATION TOUR RULES -

- 1. Entries may be accepted as valid if received by the closing date of Friday 8th February 2019.
- 2. Entries for Foals and Horses that are AWHA Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the Federal AWHA Registrations Administrator ie; all required AWHA registration paperwork and payment must be submitted in advance of acceptance of the Tour entry for classes.
- 3. Entries for Foals and Horses in the Open Classes that are Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the Federal AWHA Registrations Administrator.
- 4. No refunds after close of entries without a veterinary or medical certificate. Please note: foals entered for the 2019 AWHA National Championships Tour that are yet to be born suffering complications during or post birth, are exempt from providing a veterinary certificate. A \$15 administration fee applies irrespective of the circumstances for cancellation of entry.
- 5. Entries must include a copy of the horse/s registration papers or registration application form (if applicable). Classes are open to all horses registered with the AWHA Ltd (AWHA Ltd Stud Book, Stud Book Appendix, Warmblood Performance Registration Book (ex Warmblood Identification (WID) Register), Warmblood Foundation Mare Register (WFM) and Foundation Mare (FM)).
- 6. Handlers and riders who ARE NOT current financial members of the AWHA Ltd shall complete and sign the <u>AWHA Ltd Non-Member Application / Entry Form Release of Waiver of Liability form</u> and pay \$20 for AWHA Ltd day membership. The waiver form and associated fee must accompany your entry form. Please include the name of Handlers who are not current financial AWHA Members in your entry.
- 7. AWHA Ltd handlers and riders are to complete and sign the <u>AWHA Ltd Member Dangerous Activity</u> <u>Acknowledgement form</u>. This acknowledgement form must accompany your entry.
- 8. <u>AWHA Ltd Horse Health Declarations</u> must be **completed and signed ON THE DAY of your Class/es**. Please ensure you bring this with you and hand in to the AWHA Ltd tour representative on the day. Please note: **Hendra vaccination is not compulsory**.
- 9. Entire male horses 3 years of age and over must adhere to Equestrian Australia's <u>EA Stallion safe practices</u> <u>guidelines</u>. No colt or stallion may be presented by anyone under 18 years of age. All entire males 2 years of age and over must be led with a bridle and bit.
- 10. ASA approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding, including during warm-up.
- 11. All exhibits in ridden classes must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Use of side saddles and martingales is prohibited. Spurs must comply with EA guidelines.
- 12. All handlers and riders of exhibits (excluding colts and stallions) must be a minimum of fourteen years of age.
- 13. All horses entered in the AWHA National Championships have two Judges scoring them, so the AVG % is used for their final score.
