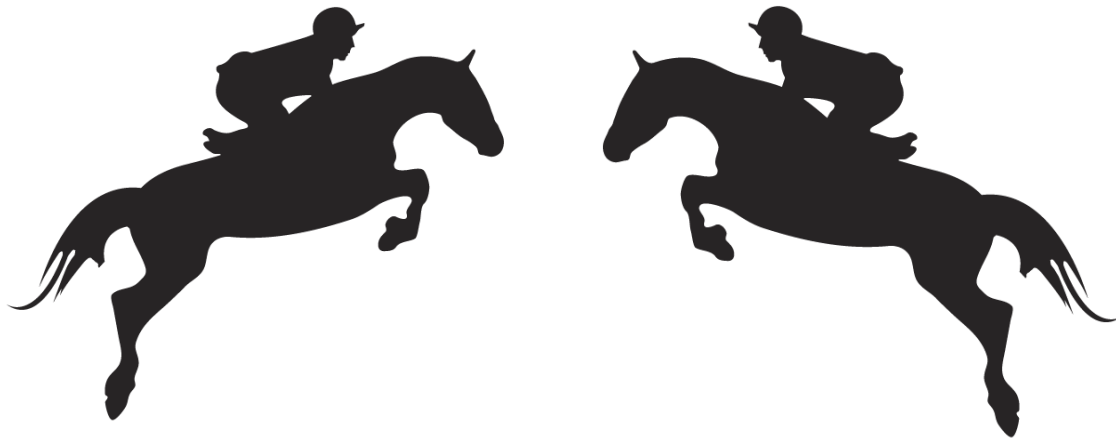

Training Rounds – Open at 8:00am

There will be 2 heights set up for training rounds first thing in the morning from 8:00am – 9:30am ONLY. For this reason, it will be first in best dressed on the entry form and spots will be limited. Heights offered are below;

A notice will go up once training rounds have been filled.

- **45cm**
- **75cm**

There will be a draw for the training rounds uploaded to Cavalletti on Thursday 6th June.

Competition Rounds – Starting at 9:45am

Places are limited and classes will be capped

Riders can only compete each horse at a maximum of 4 rounds (if completing a training round, otherwise a maximum of 3 competition rounds). Multiple competition rounds may be ridden at the same height/s however, your first round will count towards placings and the additional rounds will be H/C.

A draw will be completed for competition rounds and uploaded to Cavaletti and Facebook event on Thursday 6th June.

Committee has the right to change a class type on the day if deemed necessary.

Prizes AND prize money will be awarded to 4th place in each height class; ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

Off The Track WA are proudly sponsoring this event again! Rosettes and prizes will be awarded to high placing OTT Thoroughbreds & Standardbreds (combined) for each height round. There is also a Hi-Point **WOOLEN RUG** for the highest placed OTT of the day. Untried and unraced horses are eligible to win OTT awards. If race name is unknown, brands must be supplied.

Conditions of Entry

1. Officials and volunteers; These people are essential in the running of our competition, you must treat them all with respect. Verbal or physical abuse and poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated and will result in the termination of your entry as well as further action if necessary.
2. Competitors will not be allocated a helper duty, **however** we do ask all competitors to assist our club members where possible as we are only a small club and the smooth running of this event will depend on it. If competitors are able to support the arena crew as a first priority (picking up rails, raising heights) it would be greatly appreciated.
3. All riders must be gear checked before competing, the gear checker will be found in the warm up arena
4. The draw will be emailed out to all competitors, please ensure you have supplied a valid email address on your entry form. Draw will also be uploaded to Cavaletti and the Facebook event page
5. Riding Attire: Any colour riding attire is accepted (SHIRT MUST cover upper arms, no sleeveless shirts to be worn), approved riding boots and approved helmet are compulsory.
6. Riders can only compete each horse at a maximum of 4 rounds (if completing a training round, otherwise a maximum of 3 competition rounds). Multiple competition rounds may be ridden at the same height/s however, your first round will count towards placings and the additional rounds will be H/C.
7. The committee has the right to change class types, split classes etc. on the day if deemed necessary.
8. A rider can compete more than 1 horse if they wish. Placement in the draw will be considered if they are competing at the same height but will depend on entries.
9. Raffle will be run on the day, tickets available for purchase with entry (see entry fees on entry form) or on the day.
10. Canteen will be available on the day with snacks, lunch options & hot and cold drinks.
11. Yards are available for use on a first in first served basis. Please ensure if you use a yard you leave it clean, otherwise yards will not be available for free in the future. Please clean up your horses hay and manure from the yards and carpark, and place in our manure pile.

Jumping Penalties:

First Refusal	4 penalties
Second Refusal	8 penalties
Third Refusal	Elimination
Lowering the Height of an Obstacle (rail knocked)	4 penalties
Fall of rider	Elimination
