Competition conditions:

- Full members of the host club receive a one off \$10 discount in **total** (not per test) upon entry.
- All riders must provide a helper or self-help without exception. You cannot list another rider as your helper. Self help is via negotiation with the organisers and is very limited. Contact Corien to arrange.
Sheet collector is the only job that young person (12 years and over) may complete.
Your helper will be required for either 2 jobs or an extended helper job if you are riding more than one horse at the competition.
- Ground fees and levies are compulsory.
- Competitors in PCWA classes must be a 2019 Pony Club or Open Insured member.
- ALL other riders must be 2019 Equestrian Australia (EA) Competitor or Participant members.
- Membership cards must be supplied upon request to the organisers – no proof or membership no ride.
- Maximum of 2 horses per rider.
- Maximum of 3 dressage tests at 2 consecutive levels may be ridden per horse/pony per day.
- PCWA Open Riders may only ride in Open Classes.

- This event will be held in accordance with the current EA dressage rules (as amended) and PCAWA rules for dressage including gear check rules. **It is the responsibility of riders to know what these rules are, including PCWA Gear Check.** All rules are freely accessible via the PCAWA and EA websites.
- A separate warm up area for PCWA riders will be designated. No stallions are permitted in this area under any circumstances.
- DRAW/HELPER DUTIES – the draw & helper duties will be emailed to all competitors after 5pm Wednesday prior to the event. It is the responsibility of the competitor to check these carefully and also on the day of competition for any changes.
- It is recommended that riders check with the marshalls on the day if an arena is running to time. Please ensure that you report to Gear Check in a timely manner. Riders who do not complete a gear check will be eliminated.
- REFUNDS/SCRATCHINGS – Prior to closing date must be advised direct to Nominate 07 3118 9555 (Qld) who will refund your fees direct.
After closing entry fees will not be refunded unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 5 days of the completion of the event. In such cases a \$15 administration fee will apply.
- LUNGING – lunging is permitted in the round yard only and must adhere to either PCAWA or EA lunging rules.
- PARKING AREA/YARD CLEAN UP – please pick up and put all manure/hay from float and yards into the manure pits. Please do not put around trees.
- **Stallion** riders are required to notify the event co-ordinator in advance of their entry by email: busseltondressage@gmail.com
- A Waiver/Disclaimer must be submitted on the Nominate site or entry will not be accepted.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program or to refuse entry. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Entrants must adhere to EA and PCAWA Codes of Conduct.
- Neither the organising committee nor the affiliated bodies to which the host club belongs accepts any liability for any accident, injury, damage or illness to horses, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- **NO DOGS ARE PERMITTED ON GROUNDS AT ALL** – if you choose to bring one please do not be upset when you are asked to leave the grounds.
