Conditions:

- The Capel Adult Riding Club Inc reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any classes if warranted.
- Horses / Ponies must be nominated for each class entered with full registered name and registration number plus copies of breed certificate or a printout from the breed society as proof of registration. Current owner membership of society not required at this encourage event.
- All Stallions/Colts must wear suitable head gear & be handled / ridden by person 18 years of age or older. Stallions must wear a stallion ID disc on the head-piece (obtainable from EA).
- Ponies and Horses may enter more than one breed class if registered with each respective breed. But no classes will be held up. Please be on time and ready for your class.
- Horses/Ponies may only compete in the ridden section if they have entered the in-hand section.
- The Capel Adult Riding Club Inc and its committee, judges, helpers etc will not be liable in any way for loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators. Entry is at your own risk.
- **Exhibitors & Riders** must be a Full Member or Day Member of the CARC Inc, PCAWA, or EA. A photocopy of membership must accompany your entry or Day membership will be charged on the day.
- Place Ribbons will be awarded and Champion Tri-colour Sashes.
- **Entry Fee per exhibitor is \$8.00 per class, plus \$5.00 per horse ground Fee.**
- **Unregistered exhibits are not eligible for Supreme Champion**
- No refund will be given without a vet or medical certificate after the closing date. An admin fee of \$5 will apply
- Camping, showers, small kitchen and horse yards available on first come basis.
- **Stallion** owners must be 18 years or over. There will be a separate parking area for **stallions** located by the Camp Drafting Arena. Owners must take constant care of stallions and please don't leave them unattended. Overnight yarding is possible if the other users are aware and don't mind and there is a free yard between the next owners horse.
- No children under five (5) to compete.
- There will be a canteen on the day.
