Dynamic Neuromuscular Stabilisation (DNS) is a revolutionary new physical rehabilitation method which can literally transform the way you move through simple exercises you can perform at home. This method is different because it works at the level of the brain and central nervous system, retraining and restoring motor patterns (the "software" that "drives" our movement).

This clinic presents a unique opportunity for participants to learn about their individual functional restrictions and how this may be impacting their riding and their horse.
