- Maximum of 3 classes per horse/rider in 1 arena only. Riders are welcome to ride twice at one height however the second round and any subsequent rounds will be Non Competitive.
- All riders must complete an EA or PCWA Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement form prior to riding
- Riders must be either a member of either Margaret River & Districts Horseman's Association & Pony Club Inc ("Margaret River Pony Club") or a member of Pony Club WA or Equestrian WA.
- Riders may take out a "Day Event Membership" for \$20 to become a member of Margaret River Pony Club for the day. Membership forms available on the day.
- All riders to provide one helper per horse, limited self help available and **NO** self help if riding 2 or more horses. If you require self help please contact event co-ordinator prior to putting in your entry.
- Camping at the grounds is \$10 per person per night please email for further details
- Canteen will be operating on the day
- STRICTLY NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY
- NO DOGS ON GROUND

Conditions of Entry:

- The Committee of the Margaret River & Districts Horseman's Association and Pony Club Inc (Margaret River Pony Club) reserves the right to cancel, alter or combine any classes they may deem necessary on the day. The Margaret River Pony Club does not accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to any horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 2. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the "Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement" form must be agreed to by all entrants prior to participation.
- 3. This event is run under both Equestrian Federation of Australia (EFA) rules and Pony Club Australia Rules. All riders must be aware of the relevant rules and regulations applicable to their events.
- 4. Gear Check applicable to the type of membership you are entered under.
- 5. All entrants must be members of either Equestrian WA, Pony Club Western Australia or Margaret River & Districts Horseman's Association & Pony Club Inc, Membership cards will be required on the day.
- 6. Judges decisions are final. Under no circumstances is approaching the judge, judging or coaching from the side of the arena is permitted. Failure to abide by this rule will lead to disqualification and forfeit of entry fees. Protests must be received in writing within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, with a \$50 fee attached refund will only take place if the protest is upheld.
- 7. Refunds (less admin fee) will only be given on production of a vet or doctors certificate.
- 8. Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered.
- 9. Blue Ribbon (Class 1 in Encouragement Arena) may not enter any other class. Every clear round gets a blue ribbon.
- 10. All rings ribbons to 6th place, selected classes in Main Arena have prizes.

11. NO DOGS PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS.

Article 238.2.2 (AM5)

This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round. The jump-off may be run according to Table C.

Article 238.2.2/245.3 (AM7)

This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Athletes, who have completed their preliminary round without Penalties, must proceed to the jump-off immediately following their preliminary round. In this case, the bell must be rung again to signal the Athlete to start the jump-off course during which the 45 second rule set forth in JRs Art. 203.1.2. applies. Athletes, qualified for the jump-off, are not allowed to leave the arena, between their preliminary round and the jump-off.
