This event will be run under the auspices of Modern Pentathlon WA Association according to Modern Pentathlon UIPM Rules 2018. It will also have a <u>Pony Club Style Tetrathlon</u> run to the same style, format and rules as Pony Club Tetrathlon events. Entering this event constitutes implicit acceptance of the rules. Horses must be at least 4 years of age to compete and riders must be 8 years as of 1st January 2018. All competitors are ultimately responsible for knowing these rules and complying with them. Gear checking for safety in the Equestrian sections of both the Modern Pentathlon and Pony Club Style Tetrathlon will be conducted.

General Information:

****Fencers!** There will be separate awards for excellence in Fencing and Shooting, so even athletes who might not swim or run very well, can still come along, have fun and experience Fencing Modern Pentathlon style!

**<u>Modern Pentathletes – EOI for Pool Horses –</u> MUST be received by 18th October at the LATEST

*There will be Laser Pistols and Fencing Equipment available if needed.

*The Ride will be a Show Jumping round for Pentathlon and Hickstead/Derby style for Pony Club style Tetrathlon Event, with a Gate and Slip rail included.

*Owners/Riders who offer Pool Horses for the Modern Pentathlon Event and receive a Cash payment!!

* Owners/Riders who offer Pool Horses for the Modern Pentathlon Event ride an Owners

Training round first; and assist the rider of their horse in a 20 minute warm-up with 5 jumps *ALL riders of Pool horses are certified competent at the height entered. Owners may withdraw the use of their horse if not satisfied of rider competence during warm-up.

*Tetrathlon Riders will ride at a specific height BEFORE the Pentathlon Riders ride at the same height, so Tetrathlon Riders who are willing, will be able to offer their mount as a Pool Horse for a Modern Pentathlon rider for the same height (or higher) Pentathlon Class.

*Modern Pentathletes jumping a height lower than their age group will have points deduction of 30 points per 10cms less in height.

* Modern Pentathletes who choose to use their own horse rather than a Pool Horse will have a points deduction of 30 points.

*Modern Pentathletes in Youth Categories who don't wish to ride will be entered in the Tetrathlon (UIPM) Event.

* **Running -** Saturday 16/11/18 Swan Valley Horse and Pony Club Grounds; rear of State Equestrian Centre, Cathedral Ave, Brigadoon. 4.30pm start.

* **Ride and Shoot** – Sunday 17/11/18 Priory Park Equestrian Centre, Orange Grove Horse and Pony Club, **Height starting at 60cms** and going up as the event progresses. Start time 7.30am. Shooting Range Open at start of event - shoot in open order, when you are ready and as you arrive at the range.

* **Swim** - Sunday 17/11/18 Guildford Grammar Senior School Pool; Time TBA in Program (Published after entries close and prior to event).

* **Fencing** – Sunday at Guildford Grammar School, Priestley Hall. Time TBA in Program (Published after entries close and prior to event).

* **Laser Run** - Sunday at Guildford Grammar School, Priestley Hall. Time TBA in Program (Published after entries close and prior to event).

* Refreshments and food available at Priory Park Equestrian Centre on Sunday November 17th

* Please bring your own meals, snacks and competition requirements on Saturday 16th Nov for the Pony Club Style Tetrathlon Run.

* Competitors may only enter **one** event e.g Pentathlon, Tetrathlon (Pony Club), Tetrathlon (UIPM) or Triathle etc.

Conditions of Entry:

Equestrian Jumping phase:

- Entering the competition constitutes acknowledgement that gear checking for safety will be conducted for the riding phase of the Pony Club Tetrathlon event and Modern Pentathlon event.
- <u>Insurance:</u> ALL competitors who are not financial members of a Modern Pentathlon State Association <u>must</u> complete the Day Insurance Membership Form (see entry form).
- If competing in the Modern Pentathlon Event on a Pool Horse, riders need to provide verification to event secretary that they are certified as competent at the height they are riding from an Accredited Riding Instructor/Coach.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse as per UIPM rules
- This is a No Alcohol and non-Smoking Event
- Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control at all times
- Competitors may only ride **one** horse
- No refunds after the closing date except with a Vet. or Medical certificate. An administration fee of \$15 will be deducted.
- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times or refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

- Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- Back protectors must be worn at all heights of the Pony Club Style Tetrathlon
- Timing devices are NOT permitted for the riding phase of the Pony Club Style Tetrathlon
- EA Show Jumping Rules and UIPM Modern Pentathlon rules apply to the riding phase of the Modern Pentathlon
- Gear check is required for all riders prior to Jumping. Competitors must present to Gear Check 20 minutes prior to their allocated riding time.
- Riders entering the Pony Club Style Tetrathlon can wear their long sleeved rally shirts or Show Jumping attire as per acceptable in registered Show Jumping events.
- Lunging is only permitted in a round yard, and helmet and gloves must be worn.

Swimming phase:

• Dress for swimming phase: Wet suits may **not** be worn. Suitable swimming attire should be worn. Racing bathers, swimming caps and goggles are strongly recommended.

Running phase:

• Dress during the running phase: Running shoes with metal spikes are not permitted, rubber spikes are allowed. Competitors may not run stripped to the waist. Singlets may be worn for this phase only. Use of headphones, iPods and mobile phones are not permitted. Timing devices are not permitted for the running phase of the Pony Club Tetrathlon event.

All competitors will be given at least one helper duty; helpers nominated for more than one athlete will get more than one duty. If an athlete's helper (or a delegate) does not turn up for their designated duty, that athlete will not be permitted to complete the event and will not be eligible for any awards. *Please all pitch in and help wherever needed to make this another fun and successful event*
