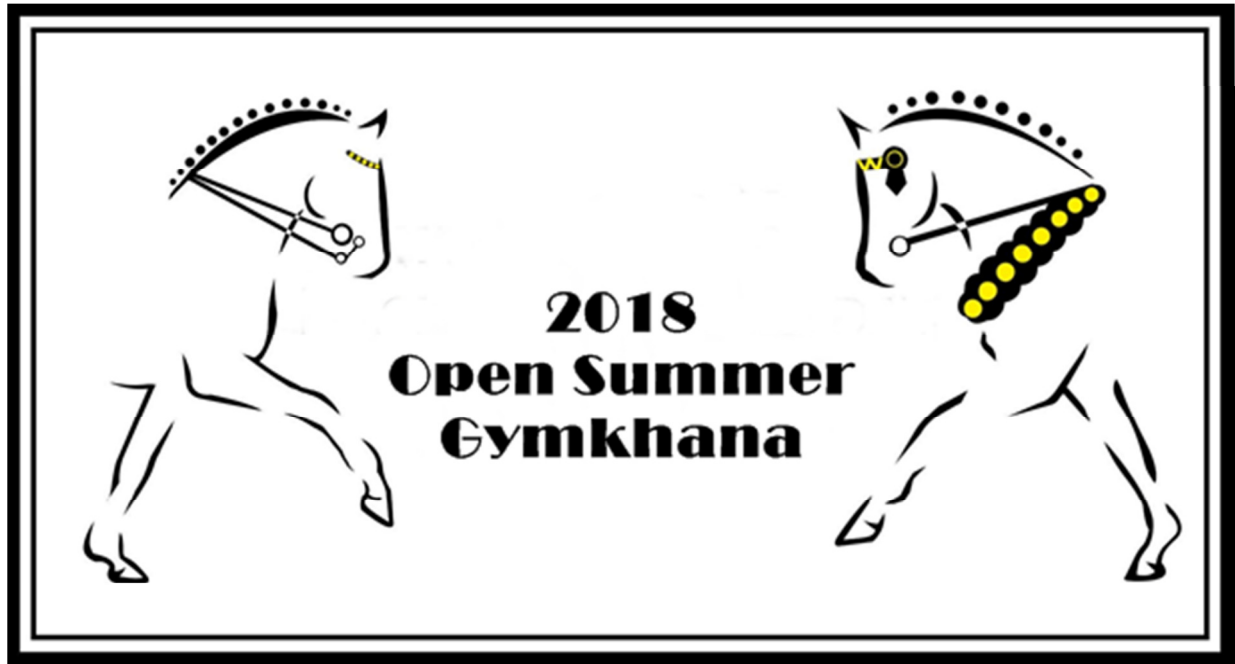

Rules/Conditions of Entry

The committee of the West Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc (WAAHA) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event/s they may deem necessary on the day.

All competitors must be a member of AHSA, WAAHA, SHCWA or EWA for insurance purposes to compete /ride on the grounds. Day membership is available for any competitor who is not a member.

OPEN TO ALL COMPETITORS (this is not just an Arabian event).

The grounds are public open space and cannot be sealed from public access.

All entrants must sign the declaration when picking up numbers or they will NOT be allowed to compete.

All persons on horseback are required to wear a recognised standards approved helmet and boots as a condition of entry (please note new helmet standards apply as of Jan 2017, it is rider responsibility to ensure your helmet complies with this).

Riders may compete in one Hack ring only. Leading Rein riders will compete in the Walk/Trot ring, but must remain on the Leading Rein in all classes.

Dressage riders must compete at the level that they AND their horses are eligible for.

All ponies can be ridden by any age unless otherwise stated.

Rider's age will be their current age on the day of event (proof of age may be requested for rider and child's classes)

Tractable stallions may be ridden by a rider 18 years or over (excluding Leadline). Stallions must be clearly identifiable at all times and must wear a green disk.

The judge's decision is final. Protests must be received in writing within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, with a \$100 fee attached – refund will only take place if the protest is upheld.

WAAHA reserves the right to interpret all rules & make decisions where any dispute arises. Under No circumstances is approaching the judge, judging or coaching from the side of the ring permitted. Failure to abide by these rules will lead to immediate disqualification and forfeit of entry fees.

Dogs on the ground must be kept securely on a leash at all times.

NO HAY is permitted outside of horse floats or trucks – Council Regulation.

Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered, unless you pay an insurance levy and sign a disclaimer.

Please take all Rubbish and Manure with you. Rubbish bags are available from the Nominations Office – Council Regulation.

The organizing committee of WAAHA inc, judges, officials, DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the 'Waiver of Liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.

Rules of Entry for Dressage

Maximum of 2 tests per rider & horse combination either same level or 1 level higher and riders must ride at the level either they or their horses' are eligible for. Horses and/or riders deemed to be competing at an unsuitable level by the organising committee may not have their entries accepted.

In the event that two tests are ridden at the same level, only the first test ridden will be counted towards any placings. Only 1 rider may ride a horse on any day.

Dressage rules as per EA Australia, but specific show rules or AHSA related rules take precedence.

Plaiting and formal attire preferred.

Boots, bandages and bell boots may be worn during warm up but must be removed before being gear checked and entering your test.

WAAHA (Inc) reserves the right to cancel/modify the event without prior notice as they see fit.

Draw will be available on www.cavalletti.com.au and emailed to all competitors by the Thursday before the event.

Placings will be awarded to 6th place in each level. Only 30 tests spots available.

Helper Duty: *All dressage and working hunter riders must pay the \$25 helper fee. This will be refunded by Direct Debit after you have been seen to have done your helper duty. The helper duty may be completed in Hacking Working Hunter or Dressage.*

WORKING HUNTER

The Working Hunter Event is conducted in three phases:

- Jumping
- Flatwork and
- In hand

The jumping phase is conducted first followed by Flat Work and then the In-hand. The rider and horse will move directly from one phase to the next. The Flat Work Phase comprised of a workout similar to a show hunter and includes a gallop and a change of lead in canter. No Lengthen trot

Classes

Leading Rein and Beginner (rider any age – pole on the ground) 30cm, 45cm, 60cm and 80cm Heights will be awarded as Junior and Senior

**Close of entries:
5th December, 2018**

Conditions of Entry:

- Horse and Rider combination may only be entered in one round competitively, additional rounds are non-competitive.
- Helper Duty must be paid and will be refunded once you have been seen to have done your duty.
- Maximum of 2 rounds per horse and rider combination
- If riding two rounds, only the first round will be counted towards any placings. Only 1 rider may ride a horse on any day.
- All gear must be safe and serviceable Snaffle bits only.
- Martingales, bandages and boots to be removed for flat workout.
- All riders must wear an approved safety helmet and riding boots at all times whilst mounted and whilst competing in the in hand phase
- Plaiting and correct attire is preferred
- Only those successful in the jumping will proceed to the flat workout.
- Maximum Height – Not all fences will be set at the maximum height for nominated classes. A minimum of one fence will be at the maximum height.
- No penalty will occur if the lower pole on the same vertical plane is lowered
- If a horse or pony jumps an incorrect fence it will be eliminated.
- Working Hunter rules as per EA Australia, but specific show rules or AHSA related rules take precedence.
