WORKING HUNTER

A Working Hunter should be of good conformation and soundness. A hunter should be able to carry its rider over a variety of terrain, they should exhibit boldness and be tractable with a free moving and balanced gait. They should work calmly and obediently without displaying over exuberance but still be happy and eager in their work.

> RING 1 – Jumping, Judge TBA RING 2 – Flat Work, Judge Alan Willett RING 3 – In Hand, Judge Megan Howe

Consists of a jumping phase, flat workout and in hand presentation.

Conditions of Entry: Horse/Pony may only compete in 2 consecutive height rounds. Classes are restricted to the first 25 entries received per class. A reserve list will be held and in the event of one class having less than 25 entries we may accept horses from the reserve list into other classes. Entries not accepted due to full classes will be fully refunded.

OPEN TO All Breeds, STALLIONS Welcome BUT must be well behaved and ridden by competent rider 14 and over.

Jumping Phase will be ridden first, only those successful in the Jumping Phase will proceed to the Flat workout. Any pony/horse eliminated or disqualified during the Jumping Section will not be required for Flatwork or in-hand sections

*Maximum Height - Not all fences will be set at maximum height for nominated class, but a minimum of 1 fence will be at the maximum height.

If a pony/horse jumps the incorrect fence it will be eliminated. Ponies/horses displaying continued disobedience or leaving the ring, whether the rider is mounted or dismounted will be eliminated.

CANCELLATION OF EVENT: If a severe weather event or other catastrophic warning is made this event may be cancelled or postponed. Contact Sue-Ellen Kiesling 0402 049 624 or check the Australian Pony Stud Book WA Branch FB Page for an update on the event.

<u>**REFUND POLICY**</u>: If an event has commenced there will be no refunds. If an event is cancelled prior to the commencement of the event – costs incurred by the show committee prior to the show will be paid and remaining funds will be reimbursed to the member if the amount per exhibitor is \$2 or more. If an event is postponed entry fees will not be refunded without a written request from the exhibitor within 7 days of the notification of postponement.

ENCOURAGEMENT WORKING HUNTER

(Encouragement Riders must not have competed in the Working Hunter at Perth Royal Show) Encouragement riders may compete in TWO consecutive encouragement heights ONLY

- 1. ENCOURAGEMENT WORKING HUNTER maximum height 30cm
- 2. ENCOURAGEMENT WORKING HUNTER maximum height 45cm
- 3. ENCOURAGEMENT WORKING HUNTER maximum height 55cm

APSB ENCOURAGEMENT HIGH POINT AWARD (must be a financial APSB member) OVERALL ENCOURAGEMENT HI POINT AWARD open to all ENCOURAGEMENT competitors

OPEN WORKING HUNTER

Riders may compete in two consecutive jumping heights

- 4. Maximum jump height 65cm
- 5. Maximum jump height 80cm
- 6. Maximum jump height 95cm

APSB OPEN WORKING HUNTER HIGH POINT AWARD (must be a financial APSB member) OVERALL OPEN HI POINT AWARD open to all Open Working Hunter competitors.

ENTRY FEES AND RULES OF COMPETITION

ENTRY FEES:APSB MEMBER ENTRY FEES\$30 PER EXHIBITALL OTHER ENTRIES\$40 PER EXHIBITGROUND FEE (INCLUDES A STABLE)\$12 PER EXHIBITBUNKROOM (UP TO 4 PEOPLE)\$66 PER NIGHT

- a. Ponies/Horses DO NOT need to be registered with any society.
- b. Riders DO NOT need to be members of any society.
- c. All Ponies/Horses must be a minimum of 4 yrs of age to enter
- d. All Riders/Handlers MUST have a signed disclaimer attached to their entry.
- e. APSB Members must be FINANCIAL to receive member's rate.
- f. A refundable cleaning fee of \$20 per entry is required for all vehicles parked on the ground. If stables are required the refundable cleaning fee of \$20.00 is per stable. These will be returned on inspection of your parking area or stables used. All Stables are locked and will be monitored. Cleaning Fees are to be handed in on the day.
- g. All classes are run under the rules as outlined below of the APSB Society WA
 - Changes of Saddlery between sections is not allowed
 - Snaffle bridle only.
 - Plaiting is optional. Neat and tidy presentation is expected.
 - All riders must wear an approved safety helmet and it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that helmets comply with the current Australian regulations.
 - Correct footwear must be worn by riders at all times, Either Jodhpur Boots/Gaiters or top boots.
 - Bandages/boots and martingales to be removed before flat work phase.
 - No Competitor will proceed past the Jumping phase if they are disqualified or eliminated.
 - Not all fences will be set at maximum Height for nominated class but a minimum of one fence will be at Maximum Height.
 - No penalty is incurred if the lower pole on the same vertical plane is lowered.
 - If a Pony/Horse jumps the incorrect fence it will be eliminated.
 - Consistent disobedience shown by a horse/pony regardless of mounted or unmounted will result in elimination.
 - Competitors **MUST** know the set ridden workout.
 - All competitors must have a strapper who is tidily presented and THEY must have appropriate footwear and be wearing an insurance armband.
- h. All riders must be wearing an insurance wrist band provided by the office.
- i. Placings to 10th Place, Heights will be awarded as Junior and Senior.
 - APSB Financial Members are eligible for the Overall APSB High Point Award.
 - Points allocated on 6 points -1st 5 points -2nd etc
- k. Working Hunter Workouts are attached.

- I. The program, timetable & judges subject to change if necessary. The organizing Committee reserves the right to add, delete or combine classes.
- m. NO dogs allowed on the grounds. Exhibitors with dogs on the ground will be ELIMINATED and asked to leave.
- n. NO refunds will be given after the close of entries other than entries on Reserve Lists that do not make a class.
