## ***RIVERS ROAD TO RECOVERY***

In June 2018, Nathan and Rebecca Purtills two year old son River John was diagnosed with Adrenal Cortical Carcinoma, and extremely rare type of cancer. Following the diagnosis, surgeons removed a large (12cm x 17cm) tumour from his little belly. River then completed six months of chemotherapy treatment at The Royal Childrens Hospital in Melbourne.

In November, the family received the news that river was in remission and loving every minute of it. The family even returned to their small home town for a few weeks!

Unfortunately that happiness was short lived when recent routine scans revealed two more tumours had formed, one near his heart and one near his liver.

They are keeping positive as there little fighter prepares for more surgeries and treatment. At such a young age, he has endured so much, but still manages to be a bright and happy little boy! You can follow River's story on Facebook - *River's Road to Recovery*

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The organisers/committee of Pinjarra Horse and Pony Club (PHPC) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they seem necessary on the day.
2. All riders must wear a current approved safety helmet and riding boots at all times when mounted on their horse/pony.
3. Hacking Jackets will be optional & short sleeves are permitted. Pony Club Uniform allowed. Riders may also use coloured jackets and coloured shirts. And horses may wear coloured saddle blankets. English gear and western gear allowed
4. All Leading Rein handlers must wear closed in footwear & ponies must be led by a single lead attached at the back of a cavesson nose band. No halters or leads with chains attached are to be used.
5. Rider's age will be as at the day of the event, proof of age may be requested.
6. Rider's over 18 years are permitted to ride ponies.
7. The PHPC reserves the right to interpret all rules & make a decision where any dispute arises.
8. The PHPC and its committee, judges and officials DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the MREC grounds is at your own risk.
9. If you are not a direct member of PHPC or EWA the \$10 competition membership form is to be filled out and submitted with entry.
10. NO DOGS allowed on the grounds.
11. No Judge is to be approached at anytime by a competitor or spectator without speaking to a PHPC committee member first.
12. Strictly NO Double Bridles.
13. HORSES ARE PERMITTED IN THE LEAD LINE/FIRST RIDDEN RING
14. A Horse or Pony that holds a Current Official Card for Show Horse are not eligible to compete. However, riders who hold a current membership with EWA or SHC are permitted to compete on a horse that does not hold an Official Card.

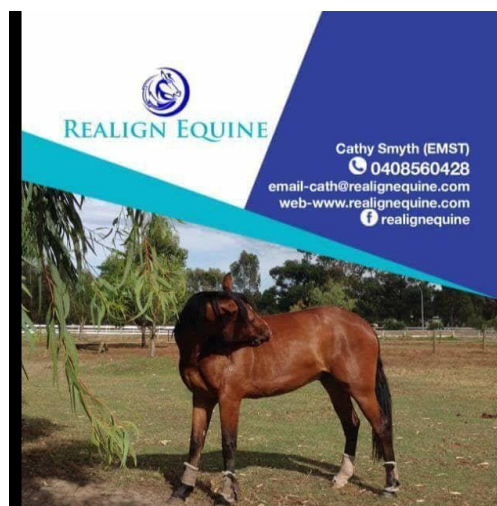
