Definitions are below:

Beginner: For riders and horses who have **very little or no experience or confidence** in the show ring. Riders can ride one or two handed in either a snaffle or a bridle. No beginner is permitted to show or handle colts or stallions. If you have placed well in previous events you may be put up to novice or open on the day, at the discretion of the CWRA show committee.

Novice: For riders who are ready and confident enough to lope/canter. This division is for people who are fairly new to this discipline. No professional or amateur riders in this class please. Riders can ride one or two handed in a snaffle or bridle.

Open: For experienced riders and horses.

Youth: Riders 3-18 years

Ranch: Beginner Youth and Adult can be walk/trot

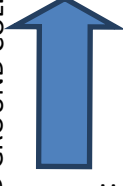

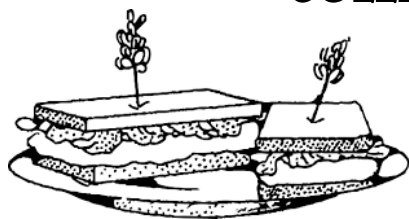

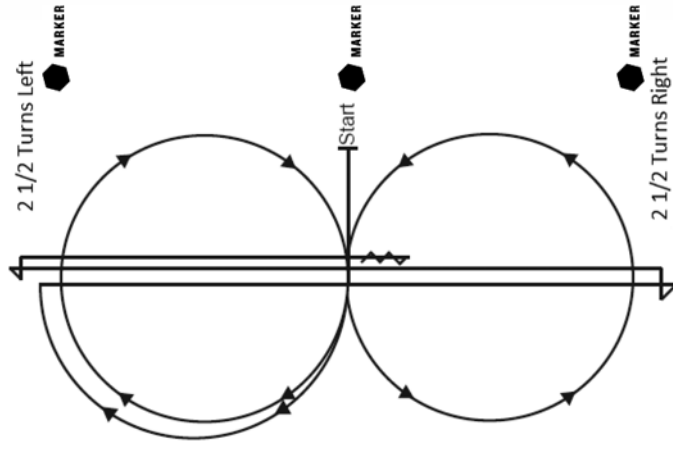

WORKING COW HORSE PATTERN 6

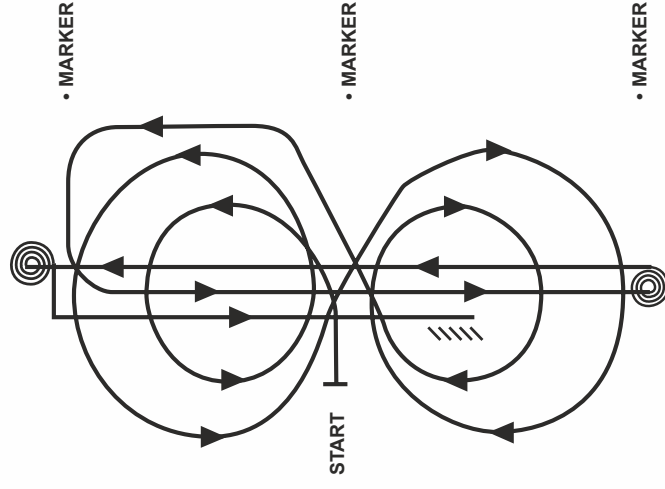
Trot to center of arena, stop. Start pattern facing towards judge

Pattern 6

1. Beginning on the right lead, lope one circle to the right. Change leads to the left.
2. Complete one circle to the left. Change leads to the right and go to the top of the arena.
3. Run down center of arena past the end marker and come to a sliding stop.
4. Complete 2 1/2 spins to the right.
5. Run to the other end of the arena, past the end marker and come to a sliding stop.
6. Complete 2 1/2 spins to the left.
7. Run past the center marker, stop, back at least 10 feet.

Hesitate to complete pattern

This pattern may be used as a lope-in pattern; refer to SHW505.2.

3 1/2 TURNS RIGHT**3 1/2 TURNS LEFT**

Trot to center of arena, stop. Start pattern facing away from judge.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete 2 circles to the left, small and slow the second circle and fast

2. Complete 2 circles to the right, the first circle and fast the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of arena.

3. Continue around end of arena without breaking galloping lead, run down center of arena, past end marker and execute a square sliding stop.

4. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the left

5. Run down center of arena, past end marker and execute a square sliding stop.

6. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the right

7. Run down center of arena, past end marker and execute a square sliding stop.

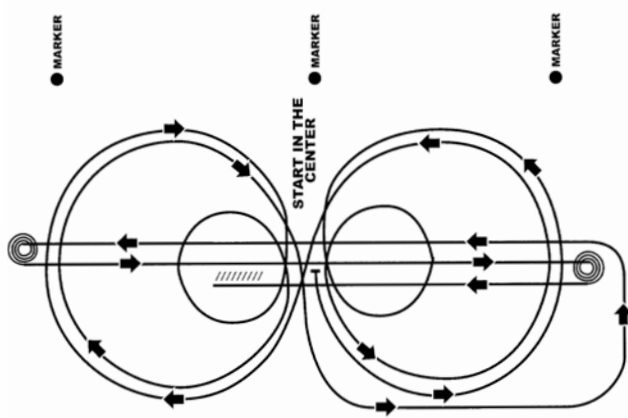
8. Back up at least 10 feet

9. Hesitate to complete pattern.

Pattern 10

1. Left circles
2. Right circles
3. Sbp
4. 3 1/2 left spins
5. Sbp
6. 3 1/2 right spins
7. Sbp and back up

WORKING COW HORSE PATTERN 2



Mandatory Marker Along Fence or Wall

Trot to center of arena and stop. Start pattern facing toward judge.

1. Pick up left lead, complete three circles to the left. The first one large and fast, the second small and slow, the third large and fast.
2. Change leads at center of arena.
3. Complete three circles to the right. The first one large and fast, the second small and slow, the third large and fast.
4. Change leads at center of arena.
5. Do not stop, continue on to run downs.
6. Run to far end past the marker to a sliding stop. Hesitate.
7. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the left. Hesitate.
8. Run to far end past the marker to a sliding stop. Hesitate.
9. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the right. Hesitate.
10. Run past center marker to a sliding stop. Hesitate.
11. Back at least 10 feet in a straight line. Hesitate.
12. Hesitate to complete pattern.

This pattern may be used as a lope in pattern; refer to SHW505.2.

WALK/TROT PATTERN For Beginner Youth & Adult

Be ready at A.

1. Walk approximately 2 horse lengths from A.
2. Jog to B. Jog a square corner around B.
3. Extend the jog to C.
4. Jog a circle at C.
5. Stop at C and back approximately one horse length.

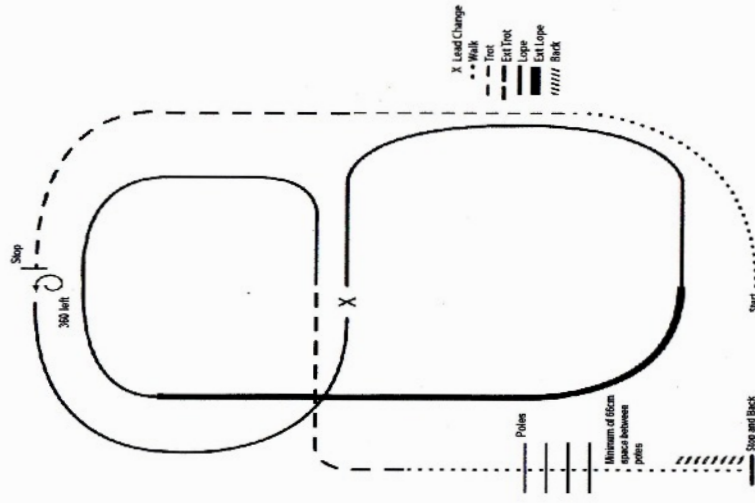

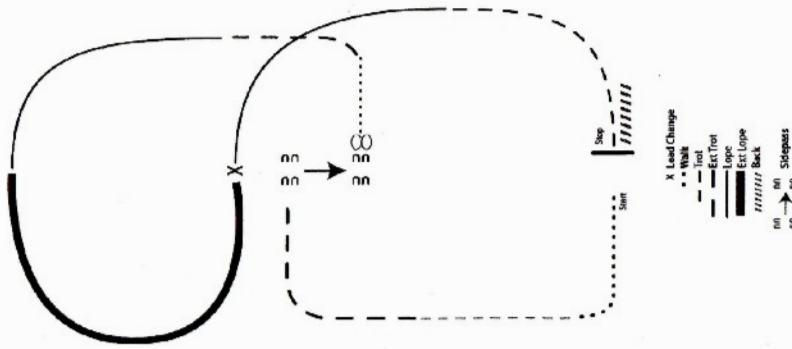
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RANCH RIDING Pattern 1



1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot, at the top of the arena, stop
4. 360 degree turn to the left
5. Left lead $\frac{1}{2}$ circle, lope to the centre
6. Change leads (simple or flying)
7. Right lead $\frac{1}{2}$ circle
8. Extended lope up the long side of the arena (right lead)
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to centre
10. Break down to an extended trot
11. Walk over poles
12. Stop and back

Ranch Riding Pattern 3



1. Walk to the left around corner of the arena
2. Trot
3. Extend alongside of the arena and around the corner to centre
4. Stop, side pass right
5. 360 turn each direction (either way first)
6. Walk
7. Trot
8. Lope left lead
9. Extend the lope
10. Change leads (simple or flying)
11. Collect to the lope
12. Extend Trot
13. Stop and back
