

## Combined Training Competition

Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> October 2018 8am start

**DUAL AFFILIATED EVENT (PCWA & EWA)** 

A competition which consists of only the Dressage and Show Jumping phases of a horse trial or ODE.

Like a horse trial or ODE, each Competitor's score is calculated by penalty points in each phase.

The Competitor with the lowest penalty score is the winner.

#### **GENERAL RULES Pony Club Classes (a):**

- 1. You must be a member of Pony Club WA (either with an affiliated club or an Open Rider) to compete in the (a) classes.
- 2. All Pony Club / Open Pony Club (a) classes are being held under Pony Club WA Rules
- 3. Pony Club WA Gear Checking will apply to all Pony Club and Open Pony Club (a) classes
- 4. All competitors and parents participating in Pony Club or Open Pony Club classes (a) must abide by the Pony Club WA Codes of Conduct
- 5. Any person aged 18 years or above as of the 1st of January must be a registered Pony Club WA Open/Competition Participant, or have a mounted Pony Club WA membership, to be eligible to enter Open PC classes (a)
- 6. Day insurance is not available for Pony Club or Open Pony Club classes (a)
- 7. RIDERS DRESS: Please refer to the Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual. All phases Official Pony Club Uniform (affiliated members) or Jacket attire (Open Riders)
- 8. HORSE DRESS: Must be plaited for dressage, all gear must meet the requirements set by the Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual. All horses must wear a number either on the near-side bridle or on the near-side saddle pad. Competitor numbers will be printed on the draw to be released on or before 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- 9. Presentations for each class will be held at the clubrooms approximately 30 minutes after the posting of the initial scoresheets. Any protests must be submitted within this initial 30 minutes or scores will stand as posted.

#### **GENERAL RULES EA Classes (b):**

- 1. Riders competing in the EA classes (b) must have current EA membership, or pay the \$15 day membership fee.
- 2. RIDERS DRESS: All phases Jacket attire or long-sleeved shirt with tie or riding club uniform, white or beige jodhpurs/breeches and riding boots.
- 3. HORSE DRESS: Must be plaited for dressage, all gear must meet the guidelines set by EA Eventing. All horses must wear a number either on the near-side bridle or on the near-side saddle pad. Competitor numbers will be printed on the draw to be released on or before 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- 4. Presentations for each class will be held at the clubrooms approximately 30 minutes after the posting of the initial scoresheets. Any protests must be submitted within this initial 30 minutes or scores will stand as posted.

#### **GENERAL RULES Other:**

- 1. An approved helmet is compulsory for anyone riding a horse. Approved helmets must be either AS/NZA 3838, or EN1384, or ASTN F1163. Failure to wear an approved helmet shall be penalised by elimination at the discretion of the Event Organiser.
- 2. Entry Fee Refunds: Entry fees will be refunded, minus an administration fee of 10%, to competitors who withdraw before the close of entries. There will be no refund for withdrawals after the close of entries, unless competitor provides a helper to complete helper duty at event.
- 3. Entries open Friday, 31st August 2018, 5am. Entries close Monday, 1st October 2018, 11pm or when full.
- 4. The same horse and rider must complete both tests and elimination from one test results in elimination from the whole competition. If equality exists, the classification is decided by the best dressage score. If equality still exists, the closest to optimum time (under the time set) in the jumping test determines the result.
- 5. Fall of Horse or Rider in any phase incurs elimination.
- 6. Error penalties incurred in the Dressage Test will be as follows

1st time	Two (2) points
2nd time	Four (4) points
3rd time	Elimination
Other errors:	Two (2) points per error to be deducted

- 7. Once competitor's dressage percentage score is calculated, it will be converted into a penalty score as per EA Eventing Rules. ie 100 minus "dressage % score" = penalty
- 8. Showjumping Penalties are as follows:

Knocking down an obstacle	4 penalties
First run-out, refusal or unauthorised circle in the whole test	4 penalties
Second run-out, refusal or unauthorised circle in the whole test	8 penalties
Third run-out, refusal or unauthorised circle in the whole test	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination

Time Faults: The length of the course and the speed demanded determine the time allowed. Completing the course in less than the time allowed in not rewarded, but exceeding the time allowed is penalised by one penalty for each commenced second in excess of the time allowed, up to the time limit, which is twice the time allowed. Exceeded the time limit involves elimination.

- 9. The Organising Committee of any event to which these rules apply does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 10. Any changes to this programme or the rules within is at the discretion of the organising committee and may be done so without notice to competitors.
