

Zamía ARC Dressage Summer Seríes Training Days

Saturday February 9th, March 9th and 23rd 7.30am start (start may be earlier if the weather is forecast to be really hot)

Parkerville Equestrian Centre, Seaborne Street Parkerville.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND INFORMATION:

START TIME 7.30am, rings may run before draw time.

Entries via Nominate, look under Dressage and select WA as the state to narrow it down.

Close on 2/2/19 for the 9/2/18 event, 2/3/2018 for the 9/3 event and 16/3 for the 23/3 event. Late entries will incur a fee and may not be accepted depending on numbers.

Please note: You may only enter and compete in two consecutive levels E.g.Preparatory/Preliminary, Preliminary/Novice, Novice/Elementary Elementary/Medium, Medium/Advanced and each horse may enter and compete in no more than 3 tests in one day.

COSTS:

\$30 for the first test, other tests \$20 per test. (please make sure you select the additional test discount button)

\$30 Helper Fee (this fee is compulsory for those who do not wish to do a helper duty) Note: Not available to ZARC members

\$5 Ground Service Fee

Tests offered

9th February: A & C Tests, 9th March B&C Tests, 23rd March A&C Tests

Higher tests available by request on each day.

The draw will be available on the Thursday prior to the event and will be emailed to entrants.

Ribbons awarded to 6th Place. Series rugs will be awarded at the end of the event on 23/3/2019 as well as prizes for completing the series.

The Zamia Adult Riding Club and its committee, judges, helpers etc, will not be liable in any way for loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators. Entry is at your own risk.

IF YOU ARE NOT A MEMBER OF ZARC, OR EWA, YOU MUST COMPLETE THE COMPETITION MEMBERSHIP FORM AND PAY THE ADDITIONAL FEE.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel, alter and delete the programme and also to refuse entry to tests. No refund will be given under any circumstances. Remember the Judges' decision is final. We are all here to have a good time and enjoy the day.

All riders MUST wear approved safety helmets at all times. Please familiarise yourself with the EA dressage rules prior to attending.

These events are training days and so plaiting is not compulsory. Adult riding club members may wear their club uniform, all other riders to present in a neat and tidy manner. Boots and bandages may be worn for warm up, but we ask that they be removed for the test so that the judge is able to see the horse's legs.

There will be a canteen available serving food and drinks.

NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS AT ANY TIME.

YOU MAY BOOK TO USE A STABLE OR YARD, THERE IS A \$50 DEPOSIT WHICH WILL BE RETURNED ONCE INSPECTED BY A ZAMIA MEMBER – PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU CLEAN ALL HAY AND MANURE TO THE MANURE PIT
