## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND INFORMATION:

- Gates will be open from 6.15
- Parking by the club rooms is for ZARC members and officials ONLY. All other riders
  are to use the "kiss and drive" circle up to the stables to unload and then park floats
  at the bottom. If you are tying to the float or using your own yards, please park at the
  bottom by the gate.
- Please report to the office prior to riding or starting your helper duty.
- START TIME 7.30am. \*Start time may be earlier if hot weather is forecast, riders will be notified with the draw.
- Rings may run before draw time, please make sure you are ready to ride at your allotted time.
- Bridle numbers have been allocated please make sure you have your numbers on both sides of your bridle or saddle blanket.
- Please familiarise yourself with the EA dressage rules prior to attending.
- All riders MUST wear approved safety helmets when mounted.
- Dress Adult riding club members to wear their club uniform, all other riders to
  present in a neat and tidy manner. Riders' boots and helmets must comply with EA
  Dressage rules.
- These events are training days and so plaiting is not compulsory, however, if your horse has never been plaited, then these events are an ideal time to see how they go with plaits in their mane. As with Rider dress, horses should be presented in a neat and tidy manner
- Boots and bandages may be worn for warm up, but we ask that they be removed for the test so that the judge is able to see the horse's legs. All other gear is as per EA Dressage Rules.
- There will be a canteen selling slices etc with tea and coffee

• IF YOU ARE NOT A MEMBER OF ZARC, OR EWA, YOU MUST COMPLETE THE COMPETITION MEMBERSHIP FORM AND PAY THE ADDITIONAL FEE.

STABLES & YARDS NOT BOOKED WILL BE LOCKED.
