Conditions of Entry

- PCAWA Classes and Open riders
 - For insurance purposes riders must be PCAWA members. OPEN RIDERS day insurance available for PCAWA classes @ \$10.00 per person.
 - Serpentine HPC members receive \$5 discount per class.
 - All classes will be subject to PCAWA rules / Gear checking and correct pony club uniform.
- No additional fees - entry fee is inclusive of all levies, First Aid and Ground fees.
- Horses can do maximum TWO rounds in arena 1.
- Horses can do maximum TWO rounds in arena 2.
- Horses can do maximum of **Three** rounds for the day
- Classes to be judged under articles 245.3/238.2.*.
- In the event of there being insufficient numbers reaching the jump off to fill all placings, minor placings will be determined on penalties in the first round and in case of equality of penalties, the time taken for the first round.
- No stallions are permitted.
- Entries online at www.globalentriesonline.com
- **Helper deposit of \$50 will be charged** on application .Helpers will be allocated jobs and must attend office for official safety equipment. Helpers names will be ticked off from the official list and the \$50 deposit will be refunded when safety vest is returned on the day. Helpers job must be entered on Global Entries. (Prize money will be withheld if Helper duties are not fulfilled)
- Riders may ride in both PCAWA classes and Open classes on the day provided:
 - Rider is a member of PCAWA or has paid day insurance of \$10.
 - Riders paying \$10 day insurance must fill out disclaimer forms before they ride.
 - Horses/Ponies may only be entered in one section of a class ie. A or B
- Ring 1 - Mounted presentations at the end of the whole class.
- Ring 2 - Mounted presentations will be conducted at the end of each class division .
- “Am7” classes will be run under FEI article 238.2.2 and 245.3
- Dogs **must** be kept on leads
- Parking is only permitted along the road side of the grounds - no parking permitted on the ovals or dividing tree line.
- Please remember to clean up your area around your float before you leave, put manure in allocated bays – otherwise our committee members have to come around the carparks and clean up your mess before we get to go home or we are charged additional fees by the council.
- Prizes/prize money for classes may be dependent on sponsorship and entry numbers
- Organisers reserve the right to change the program
- Serpentine HPC will be operating the canteen
- Entries received after closing day will only receive refund minus \$10 with a Vet certificate
- Organisers reserve the right of cancellation if conditions are considered too dangerous.
- We retain \$5 per round portion of entry, fees to cover administration costs.
