Hickstead Information

The Hickstead day is organised as two phases – Dressage and Jumping.

The jumping will involve a combination of show jumps and cross country jumps. The scores for each stage are given as penalty points and are added together to give a total.

On arriving at the competition, you must present to the club rooms to register, you will need to show your insurance & medical armband to receive your bib number and confirm your helper duty.

Limited number of stalls and yards are available on a first come basis. All manure is to be removed from stalls, yards and grounds and placed in the manure pile located behind the stalls. No self help is available for this event.

Dressage

- Gear Check. You must present mounted, with all equipment (helmet, whip etc.) to the gear check area at least 15 minutes before your dressage time.
- A copy of your test will be available from the club rooms after all the dressage tests for your class have been completed.

Jumping

- A course map for the jumping phase will be available on the day.
- Gear Check. You must present yourself mounted for gear check area at least 15 minutes before your Jumping time.
- Walliston Riding & Pony Club has a short cross country course which includes a water jump.
- Hickstead Combined Jumping penalties will apply (article 18).
- Stop watches are not permitted to be worn for the jumping phase.
- Optimum time for jumping phase are to be published on the events maps.

Rules

- This event will be run under Pony Club WA Hickstead Rules.

- PCWA gear checking rules apply.
- Scoring will be as PCWA 2018 Hickstead rules.
- Mount may compete in PCWA Hickstead's from the beginning of the calendar year in which it turns 5 years old.
- Open riders must hold PCWA Open or Competition registration and must show proof of current rider registration.
- Max. 2 horses per rider.
- Riders must provide own competitor number holders/bibs.
- All horses must have a saddle cloth or bridle number in addition to rider bibs.
- Body protectors and long sleeves are MANDATORY for jumping phase.
- Medical armbands are compulsory with up to date details.
- No Stallions are allowed at Pony Club events.
- There will be no veterinary service at this event.
