Poles – 30cm
45cm
65cm
80cm
95cm
105cm

- Entry includes 2 jump rounds
- Rounds must be consecutive heights; the same height may be completed twice however the 2nd round will be considered non-competitive

EVENT INFORMATION

Hickstead is a smaller version of an ODE, including a dressage test and a jump course built of show jumps and cross-country obstacles. Riders must complete 2x jump rounds and 1x dressage test.

The aim of the event is to receive the lowest amount of penalties across both the dressage and jumping phases.

General Rules

- All manure must be cleaned up by yourself when you leave, this includes the car park. All stables **MUST** be left clean
- Competition clothing or club uniform allowed
- Plaiting optional
- Gear check will be run under ARCA Hickstead rules
- Wanneroo Adult Riders reserve the right to change or amend the program
- \$600 Jackpot for the Champion Hi-Point rider whom attends ALL 3 shows in the series
- Penalty points from both phases will be calculated at the end of the day to determine the winners
- Riders who have been eliminated during any phase are not eligible for placings
- Presentations will be held at the end of the day
- It is expected that all competitors remain at the grounds until presentations are completed to receive ribbons and support other competitors
- Unfortunately, there is no camping on the grounds during this time. For anyone needing to camp, please contact the SEC as the closest equine camping area

Jumping Phase

- A course map will be available on the day and the course available for walking from 7am until 7.30am and shortly between each height class
- Gear check must be completed before any competitors proceed through to the course. You **MUST** present yourself mounted, with all equipment meeting ARCA gear check rules and helmets meeting EA standards
- Body Protectors **MUST** be worn during the Jumping Phase due to the use of cross-country jumps
- No timing devices or watches allowed
- All jumps are numbered
- Cross-country obstacles are flagged with a WHITE flag on the left and a RED flag on the right. All jumps and obstacles must be jumped in the correct order and direction, failure to do so will result in elimination
- There may be 'Compulsory Flags' which require you to pass through them during the course
- The START and FINISH flags must be passed at the start of the course and after the course completion for the timing to be calculated
- Penalties given for refusals, run outs, course error etc.
- Any rider fall will result in elimination and riders **MUST** report to First Aid
- The jumping phase **MUST** be completed mounted, there is to be no leading of a horse over any part of the course
- The judge will determine optimum time for each class
- Length of the course will not be provided

Dressage Phase

- Gear check must be completed before any competitors proceed through to the course. You **MUST** present yourself mounted, with all equipment meeting ARCA gear check rules
- Once you have been marshalled through, present to the judge in the car. The judge will ask for your name, you will then be asked to proceed towards A. A horn will be beeped, or a bell rung when the judge is ready for you to begin your test
- Your test will be available at the clubhouse after all the scores have been noted down at the end of your class
- Callers are allowed for Preparatory tests only
- The scores will be calculated as per eventing rules.... the lower the score, the better the test!

Helper Duty

- All competitors MUST nominate a helper on the day self-help is available, however, there are limited spots
- A \$30 refundable helper duty fee is payable upon entry and will be refunded after the event provided your helper duty was completed
- Helper duties will be assigned and provided with the draw
