SUNDAY 14th APRIL SHOW JUMPING COMMENCING 9AM

Show Jumping course will be open for walking at 8.30am

Gear check will commence at 8a.m.

Open to all PCWA riders including affiliate and open riders, current PCWA card must be shown on the day with a copy also attached to entry form email.

Non-Zone Horse/Rider combinations may enter 2 consecutive jumping heights, with a maximum of 3 rounds from classes 11-26 on the program.

Zone Classes run as a Table A Competition. Zone competitors will jump two rounds over the same course on the same day at the **highest height** they wish to compete at. (Choose 1 (one) class from classes 1 – 4).

Zone class riders may also enter 2 x classes from classes 11-26 on the program at the same height and within 1 (one) consecutive height (either higher or lower) than already entered in Zone class.

Age groups will be determined by age as of January 1st 2019.

4. 110 cm (**Avon zone members Qualifier**) riders 12 to 24 years

NO CLASS CHANGES ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **Pre entries only**- no entries on the day
- Event will be run under PCAWA rules. For more details on rules go to www.ponyclubwa.asn.au
- Riders must wear Formal Pony Club uniform (PCWA classes). Open classes as per PCWA Gear check manual; JACKET – Must be worn with long/short sleeved/sleeveless shirt and Tie/Stock/Ratcatcher. Jacket must not be removed without permission of the Judge. Long sleeves must be worn if jacket is allowed to be removed. Sleeves must NOT be pushed or rolled up. Service (e.g. Police Force) uniform permitted.
- All riders must be gear checked before competing. PCWA gear checking rules will apply for all classes and competitors are responsible for being aware of these rules.
- **All riders to provide one helper per horse**, limited self-help available, no self-help if riding 2 or more horses unless by prior arrangement. If you require self- help we would prefer if you choose set-up/ pack away as your helper duty. If a person is named as a helper for more than one rider, more than one job will be given.
- At discretion of the Show jump committee, riders who do not complete their helper job, may be eliminated or refused entry at future events.
- There will be **no non-competitive** rounds available so **you cannot jump the same height twice on the same horse**.
- One horse, one rider. Maximum of 3 horses per rider. Maximum of 2 horses per rider in any one height.
- Zone classes are a Table A (not against the clock) competition run under FEI rules. Competitors will jump 2 rounds over the same course on the same day. The faults of both rounds will be added together and the competitor with the least number of faults will be the winner. In the event of an equality of faults over the 2 rounds for any placing, there will be a jump off over a reduced number of obstacles, which may be raised. If there is an equality of faults in the jump-off, time will be the deciding factor. Heights will be unchanged for the second round but the jump-off may be raised by up to 10cm.
- All other classes are either an AM7 or optimum time event.
- Avon Zone placings will be given for events 1,2,3 and 4 for Avon Zone riders wishing to qualify for the PCAWA State Show jumping Championships.

Current height certificates may be necessary

Scratching's/Refunds: Competitors must notify the organisers of withdrawal prior to close of entries to obtain a refund minus \$5 book keeping fee.

After this date, a refund will only be given if a Vet or Doctor's certificate is received by the organiser within 2 weeks of the event. A \$10 book keeping fee will apply.

The draw will be posted online on the Thursday prior to the event
