COMPETITORS MUST BE EITHER CURRENT PONY CLUB WA RIDING MEMBERS OR COVERED BY PONY CLUB WA INSURANCE

As a Zone you need to ask your riders who are wanting to compete as Zone qualifier, to complete the associated paperwork in the SJ reference document (Appendix 3) and have it signed by their club BEFORE attending the event and to hand it into the SJ office on the day (at Wanneroo). We will send results to the zone with associated paperwork.

Reminder: Horse/Rider combination can only do 4 rounds per day. Zone Selection classes are two rounds each.

COSTS: \$10 per round – Blue ribbon rounds (only one round per height) \$15 per round – Open classes (only one round per height) \$20 – Zone Selection classes

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

<u>Entries</u>: Please complete an Online Entry at <u>www.globalentriesonline.com.au.</u> Please register under rider name, not parent. If you have any queries, please email <u>showjumping@ponyclubwa.asn.au</u> or contact the Pony Club WA Office on 9296 1500.
 <u>Entries close 5pm April 12th 2019</u>.

All riders will be required to provide a helper. Helper duties not completed will result in the rider being disqualified and ineligible for Zone Selection.

- 2. <u>Rules</u>: The event will be held in accordance with the current Pony Club WA, Equestrian Australia and FEI rules. It is your responsibility to be aware of and comply with the rules. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to alter and amend the program.
- 3. <u>Gear Checking</u>: All riders must comply with the Pony Club WA Gear Checking Rules. These are available from the Pony Club WA website. <u>http://ponyclubwa/gear_checking</u>.
- 4. <u>Horse and Rider Combinations</u>: A maximum of 4 rounds may be completed on the day. Riders or horses may be changed before the start of competition (class); however, a rider of a horse may not be changed if another rider has ridden the horse on the day, either in warmup or in competition. The draw position cannot be changed without the permission of the Organizing Committee.

<u>SUMMARY OF ZONE CLASS CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT</u>: This is a competition over two rounds (not against the clock) with a jump-off against the clock if required, run under Table A FEI Rules for Jumping Competitions Each competitor will jump two rounds over the same course, as directed in the 2019 SJ Reference Document.

- 5. <u>Eligibility for Pony Club Riders</u>: To be eligible to represent a Pony Club, the rider must be a financial member of an Affiliated Pony Club WA Member Club. The rider must compete in their formal Pony Club uniform.
- 6. <u>Eligibility for Open Riders:</u> Pony Club WA Open Rider or mounted membership with a Pony Club WA Member Club is mandatory, regardless of other affiliations and insurances held. The Open Rider must compete in attire in accordance with the Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual. If you are unable to produce your membership confirmation you will not be able to ride on the grounds and will not be refunded any monies paid.

- 7. <u>Helpers</u>: must report to the Information desk to sign in for their duty. It is the rider's responsibility to check the list of helper duties which will be available with the draw.
- 8. <u>Draw:</u> The draw will be emailed to all competitors after 5pm Wednesday, 17th April 2019 (ensure your email address is up to date). Amendments to the draw may be possible but no later than 48 hours before the start of the event. Responsibility is on the competitor to check the draw on the day of competition. Whilst every attempt will be made to adhere to the start times in the draw (if available), it is the rider's responsibility to be aware via the Marshall/ Gear Checker if an arena is running ahead of schedule. It is recommended that competitors report to the Marshall/Gear Checker for inspection at

It is recommended that competitors report to the Marshall/Gear Checker for inspection at least 20 minutes prior to competing. Riders who do not complete a gear check will incur elimination. Gear check is per Pony Club WA guidelines.

- **9.** <u>Presentations:</u> Presentations will take place mounted during the event if time permits or can be collected from the Office. An announcement will be made to clarify.
- **10.** <u>Catering</u>: Food and Beverage will be available for purchase on the day.
- 11. <u>Yards</u>: There are no yards at Wanneroo Horse & Pony Club, but portable yards are permitted.
- 12. <u>Refunds and Scratching</u>: Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 7 days of the completion of the event minus an Admin Fee of 20% of entry fees.
- **13.** <u>Disclaimer of Liability</u>: Neither the Organizing Committee, nor the Pony Club WA accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. ALL riders MUST have signed a disclaimer as part of their membership prior to participation. This is a condition of insurance.
- **14. <u>Swabbing</u>**: Random swabbing may take place and will be in accordance with EA Veterinary Regulations.
- **15.** <u>**Protests and Appeals**</u>: These must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$50 and taken to the Ground Jury.
- **16.**<u>Lunging</u>: There is **NO** lunging in the warm up arena. If you wish to lunge your horse you must do so away from the main arena so as not to interfere with other competitors. Correct protocol in the warm up arena is expected.
- 17. <u>Officials and Volunteers</u>: These people are essential in the running of our competitions and events. Please treat them with respect. Poor sportsmanship, verbal or physical bullying behavior will not be tolerated. This may be reported to the relevant authority and disciplinary action will be taken where appropriate.
- **18.** <u>Duty of care</u>: It is your responsibility to promptly report unsafe and or hazardous situations to the Organizing Committee.

19. Warm up Arena Etiquette:

As there are many horses warming up in a restricted area it is important that all riders have knowledge of the etiquette required in group riding. This ensures safe riding and achieves harmony in busy areas.
