EVENTING IN THE LOOP

SUNDAY 26th MAY

Hickstead is an exciting jumping competition which combines the skill and accuracy of showjumping with the bravery of cross country into 1 round.

Each competitor will jump 2 rounds at 1 height only and the combined score from both rounds will decide placings.

In the event of a draw of penalty scores, the closest to the optimum time will decide the winner.

Classes:

45cm: PCWA and Open

65cm: PCWA and Open

80cm: PCWA and Open

\$65 per horse

Closing date for entries: Monday 20th May

Draw will be published on Cavalletti approx. Thursday 23rd May

One horse one rider rule will apply to all classes.

All PCWA riders will compete together regardless of the rider's age.

Ribbons to 6th place.

This event is run under the latest Hickstead rules (currently 2019 Pony Club WA Hickstead Rules)

All competitors are ultimately responsible for knowing these rules and complying with them. PCWA gear checking rules apply. No gear check = no start

1 horse may only compete at 1 height. Max 2 horses per rider

Rider must be 9 years old as at 1st Jan 2019 to compete in this event in 45cm and 65cm classes.

Rider must be 11 years old as at 1st Jan 2019 to compete in this event at 80cm.

Mount may compete in Hickstead from the beginning of the calendar year in which it turns 5 years old. Owner/rider is to provide proof of horse's age if requested.

Open riders must hold PCWA open or Competition Participant insurance.

PCWA cards and Open rider Insurance cards must be sighted by the office before entry. No exceptions.

No watches or timing equipment allowed.

Rider must provide their own number holder/bibs.

All horses to have a bridle number in addition to the rider number.

Body protectors and long sleeves are mandatory.

Medical armbands with the correct information must be worn.

For each horse entered there needs to be a nominated helper over the age of 16 to complete a helper job, ie 2 horses = 2 helper jobs.

Limited self-help will be available and must be pre-arranged by SMS to Paula Vaughan on 0432283908 – you will be allocated a job before, after or between your ride times. Self-help is not available to riders with more than 1 horse.

Additional Information

There are a number of day yards for horses. These are available on a first come first served basis.

Camping is available Sat night but the canteen will not be open so please bring your own food and supplies.

Manure can be scattered across the grounds. Please DO NOT leave manure around trees as this ultimately kills them

The canteen will be open on the day of the competition for you to purchase hot and cold food and drinks.
