Join us in the indoor arena for pole and roping clinic's along with obstacle practice all on the Saturday and a Jackpot race day on the Sunday!

### Saturday 20<sup>th</sup>

Pole Clinics held by Gina Crawford, 3 sessions 9-10, 10-11 & 11-12 - \$25.00

Pole work is a great way to work your horse, these clinics will help you and your horse in multiple ways! Get your horse lifting their feet and bending correctly to benefit you when going over obstacles so your horse doesn't trip and fumble! Sessions are limited to 6 riders. Fence sitting is available

Roping Clinic held by Donna Barnett, 3 Sessions 12-1, 1-2 & 2-3 - \$25.00

Learn how to rope a cow the right way and have fun while doing it! Be shown the right way to hold a rope, coil the rope and rope our dummy cow. Sessions are limited to 6 riders. Fence sitting is available.

Obstacle Practice 3pm-5pm - \$15.00

The arena will be open for you to practice with the obstacles at your leisure

## Sunday 23rd

<u>9am start Jackpot race day, please see second page for costs</u> – Riders will compete in their divisions in specified order, the race course and order of run will be revealed an hour prior to the race commencing. Riders will need to be available for a walk through before their division starts, this is done without horse/pony.

Order of racing is determined by the reverse order of received nominations.

#### If you want to run last, then get your entry in first.

There will be an awards presentation held in the afternoon once all divisions have completed their race, this includes cash prizes from the jackpot race.

A 50% deposit is required to secure your place in the events.

WCC reserves the right to change the venue at any time, you will be notified of any changes. Payments are non-refundable after 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019 unless a veterinarian certificate or doctors' certificate is produced.

## Division information & Prices Poles, Roping & Racing – 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> July 2019

Divisions will run in order as listed below. Please note; Competitors must be available for their walkthrough with the judge before their division starts.

Competitors are allowed to nominate for multiple divisions – please read the rules if you want to nominate for multiple divisions (or email us for advice).

LEAD-LINE: Any ages up to 7 years of age

**YOUNG GUNS:** Minimum age of 7 years – maximum age of 11 years. Any rider between the age of 7 and 11 are eligible to compete in the Young Guns Division. Young Gun riders are allowed to ride "up" into Youth Divisions with parental permission.

YOUTH: Minimum age of 7years – maximum age of 17 years

**GREEN HORSE:** A division to bring along young horse and futurity horses.

- A division to develop aged horses that are new to EXCA and Futurity horses.
- For horses of any age.
- A Green Horse may be ridden by any competitor over the age of 12.
- A Green Horse can NOT be ridden in any other division.

**NOVICE:** 18 years and older. The novice division is designed for beginner riders that are new to the sport of Extreme Cowboy Racing.

**INTERMEDIATE**: An intermediate rider is an individual who is ready to move out of the Novice Division but is not yet ready to compete in the Non-Pro Division. An individual in this division has had some competition experience in other equestrian sports.

NON-PRO: A Non-Pro rider is an individual that has experience as a rider but does not receive any form

of compensation for riding or training horses. This definition applies to all riders over the age of 18.

**RIDE SMART 55+:** The Ride Smart Division is designed for non-professional riders over the age of 55.

**PRO:** An individual is considered a professional if he/she is aged 18 or over and receives substantial compensation or works full time riding or training horses.

PLEASE NOTE: The order of run, shall be determined by the reverse order of WCC receiving entry

nominations. Therefore, if you wish to run last and watch the other competitors in your division, then you must get your nominations in early. If you nominate on the day, then you will be running first in your division.
