DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS

OPTIMUM TIME – run under Table A: The rider endeavours to ride the course according to how the judge has measured the course and speed it should be ridden at. The rider closest to the time with the least amount of faults is the winner. The overall rider closest to the optimum time will win the trophy rug for that class!

SUPER TWO PHASE – run under Table A: The course consists of 11-13 jumps and two phases that run without interruption. The first phase is 5-7 jumps that are completed not against the clock. The finish flags for the first phase are the beginning of the second phase which is ridden against the clock and comprises of 4-6 obstacles. Unless eliminated, riders penalised in the first phase may continue in the second phase. The winner is according to the aggregate penalties in both phases and, if necessary, according to the time of the 2nd phase.

OTT: This class is for OTT thoroughbreds and Standardbreds. This class will be included within every height. Ribbons will be awarded 1st – 6th as well as points which will be tallied and the rider with the most points at the end of each day will win the woollen rug for best performed OTT Thoroughbred and OTT Standardbred of the day.

PLEASE REGISTER YOUR OTT HORSE THE MORNING OF THE SHOW TO BE ELEGIBLE FOR THE OTT AWARDS

No entries on the day – Entries via Global Entries

- **THIS SHOW IS RUN UNDER EA INSURANCE AND EA RULES - IF YOU DO NOT HAVE EA INSURANCE, DAY INSURANCE IS AVAILABLE**
- **CLASSES WILL BE CAPPED AT 20 RIDERS, so get your entries in early!!**
- **PLEASE NOTE RIDERS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO ENTER 3 ROUNDS OVER 3 CONSECUTIVE HEIGHTS**
- Riders are permitted to wear hacking jacket or official pony club uniform
- Classes will be broken into 3 groups: Rider 13 yrs and under, Rider 14 yrs up to and including 25 yrs and rider over 25 yrs. Ribbons awarded up to 6th place.
- The 30cm, 105cm and 115cm classes will not be broken into age groups
- **30CM RIDERS CAN BE ON LEAD LINE OR HAVE A PARENT IN THE RING HELPING**
- Rosettes and rugs can be collected from the club room after results are announced
- **PLEASE NOTE THAT THE 30CM CLASS IS CLASSED AS AN ENCOURAGEMENT ROUND AND IS DESIGNED FOR YOUNG/GREEN HORSES AND RIDERS. LEAD LINE RIDERS ALSO WELCOME IN THE 30CM CLASS**

GENERAL INFORMATION

Ring will be opened for walking before start time

Courses will be open for walking after each height change

EA rules apply for this event

Horses must be 4 years and older at the time of the event

Rider's age is at the time of entry

Horse and rider combinations can enter maximum 3 rounds over 3 consecutive heights

Ground fee is per horse

Horse and rider combinations can enter a class twice, but the second round and all rounds after that will be non-competitive

Pinjarra Horse and Pony Club retains the right to change the program at any time or reschedule the event

Every rider must first register before mounting

Refunds minus \$10 admin fee will be available upon presentation of doctors or vet certificate once draw is posted

CAMPING

Camping is available upon consultation with the event organisers. Toilets, showers and yards available. Camping is \$5 per horse, if using your own yards; a car must be connected to the float at all times.

PARKING AND YARDS

Plenty of parking is available on the grounds as well as yards which are for everyone to use, no booking required. There are manure pits available on the grounds that must be used when cleaning out the yards before leaving

Please leave the grounds as found, and take all horse poo, hay and rubbish home with you
No riders under the age of 18 to be left on grounds without a parent/guardian

OTT Entries

If entering an Off The Track horse, race name and show name must be provided. If this is not known, microchip and/or brands are to be supplied. This information will then be supplied to the RWWA Off The Track sponsorship team after the show as well as photos of the rug recipients and competitors.

Canteen will be available on the day

Gates open at 6:00am

****COMPULSORY HELPERS****

Each rider must nominate a helper that is competent to do any of the helper tasks they are assigned. One horse – One helper – if the same helper is nominated for more than 1 rider they will get more than one job. **Very limited self-help is available and only in consultation with the event organiser by email or phone call and will be either set up or marshal/gear checker.** No self-help is available for riders with 2 horses competing.
