- BEPC members will be given a \$10 refund after the event, on the condition that they participate in set up &/or pack up unasked.

PLEASE NOTE: All riders must have current Pony Club WA membership/insurance. All riders must be able to present confirmation of membership when you pick up your bib numbers. The Event Secretary has the right to refuse any entry if you do not comply, with or without stating a reason.

PAYMENTS & ENTRY

Entries will be open on K-trials. Payment is via K-trials (Pay Pal).

REFUNDS

Refunds will be given up until the closing of entries date by cancelling your entry on ktrails, after which, will strictly only be **considered** upon provision of a medical certificate or vet certificate, where a deduction of a \$20 admin fee applies. Refunds will not be considered for any other reasons.

COMPULSORY HELPERS

Each rider must nominate a helper over the age of 18yrs.

One Horse – One Helper – the same helper cannot be nominated for more than 1 horse or they need to do 2 duties.

NO self help is available.

If a helper does not report or do their duty the rider is eliminated.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Any one rider can only enter a maximum of 2 horses.
- Any horse and rider team can only enter 1 class.
- No rider under 18 years is to be left on the grounds without a parent/guardian.
- No helmet cameras of any description are permitted.
- **VET on call only:** fees are payable by parties that authorise the services of a vet.
- Qualified First Aid will be on the grounds.
- Canteen will be available.
- No Dogs allowed at any time on the grounds.
- Gates open 7am, dressage commences at 9am (see updated draw as this may change)
- Draw will be posted on KTrials in reports section
- Class 9 – 30cm does not form part of the series

COMPETITORS PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE READY ON TIME FOR EACH PHASE AS EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO RUN ON TIME.

AWARDS

Ribbons awarded to 6th place in all classes. Presentations are unmounted and will be held in front of the clubhouse at the completion of scoring.

Eligibility for the series requires riders to complete at a minimum of 2 series events of which event 3 is mandatory. If a rider competes successfully and places at all 3 events then all 3 event points will go towards the series. If a rider completes at 2 events (1 or 2 and the 3rd event) and places at both events, then their points go towards the series.

Event 1 – 13th April 2019

Event 2 – 21st July 2019

Event 3 – 5th October 2019

We welcome and encourage riders to upgrade during the series, as appropriate, and one set of upgrade points (changing from one grade to a higher grade) can be applied at the end of the series. Upgrade points apply if the upgrade is successful and the combination is not eliminated. If a horse and rider combination are eliminated at one of the events, they are no longer in the running for the series but are very welcome to compete at all events.

If a rider downgrades at the second or third event, no points will be awarded at the lower height and no future upgrade points can be applied.

Series Winners - Rugs will be awarded to the horse/rider combination in each class scoring the most points over the 3 events. Prizes will be dependent on sponsorship.

GEARCHECK

Pony Club WA gear check rules apply, no exceptions. **All** competitors must complete gear check before each of the phases. All competitors must wear their numbers when mounted and must supply their own bib.

HORSE AGE

A horse may compete in competitions from the beginning of calendar year in which it turns 5 years.

OBJECTIONS

Protests are to be lodged with the appeals committee in writing, together with \$50, within 30 minutes of the scores being posted. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final and the \$50 will be returned if the protest is upheld.

PARKING

Parking is limited at Baldivis Equestrian & Pony Club. All vehicles must obey the directions of the parking attendants or their connections will be disqualified from competing. **STRICTLY NO PORTABLE YARDS ALLOWED AT THE SIDE OF FLOATS.**

A limited number of day yards are available on a first come first served basis for a small fee through Ktrails.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The Organisers reserve the right:

- To cancel any class or event
- To divide any class
- To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- To alter the advertised times
- To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
