Combined Training Competition

A competition which consists of only the Dressage and Show Jumping phases of a horse trial or ODE.

Like a horse trial or ODE, each Competitor's score is calculated by penalty points in each phase.

The Competitor with the lowest penalty score is the winner.

Class:	Dressage Test	Showjumping
1	Prep C (open to lead-line)	Poles to 30cm
2	Preliminary 1C	45cm
3	Preliminary 1C	65cm
4	Eventing Test – EvA Test A 80 2019	80cm

3 - Event Series

Event 1 – 28th April 2019 Event 2 – 7th July 2019 Event 3 – 22nd September 2019

Horse/Rider Combinations must attend at least 2 of the 3 series events to qualify for Series Prizes.

Points will be allocated at each event as follows

1st - 7pts, **2nd** - 6 pts, **3rd** - 5pts, **4th** - 4pts, **5th** - 3pts, **6th** - 2pts, **Completion without elimination** - 1pt

Horse/Rider combination with the highest amount of points for the height class at the end of the 3rd series event, is the winner.

If a horse/rider combination changes height class from one event to the other, they do not carry their previously earned points with them. Eg - if horse/rider combination is awarded 1st place in the 30cm at the first event, they will receive 7 points towards the 30cm prize. If the second event, they move to the 45cm class, they do not take their 7 points with them into the 45cm class.

GENERAL RULES:

1. This is a non-pcwa sanctioned event. It is open to everyone. However, all riders must sign a disclaimer before their class.
2. This event will use the guidelines set out in Annex J Combined Training, with some alterations.

3. An approved helmet is compulsory for anyone riding a horse. Approved helmets must be either AS/NZA 3838, or EN1384, or ASTN F1163. Failure to wear an approved helmet shall be penalised by elimination at the discretion of the Event Organiser.
4. RIDERS DRESS: All phases - Jacket attire or long-sleeved shirt with tie or riding club uniform, white or beige jodhpurs/breeches and riding boots.
5. HORSE DRESS: Plaiting preferred for dressage, all gear must meet the guidelines set by EA Eventing.
6. Presentations for each class will be held at the clubrooms approximately 30 minutes after the posting of the initial scoresheets. Any protests must be submitted within this initial 30 minutes or scores will stand as posted.
7. Entry Fee Refunds: Entry fees will be refunded, minus an administration fee of 10%, to competitors who withdraw before the close of entries. There will be no refund for withdrawals after the close of entries, unless competitor provides a helper to complete helper duty at event.
8. Entries open Monday, 3rd June 2019, 5am.
9. Entries close Monday, 1st July 2019, 11pm or when full.
10. The same horse and rider must complete both tests and elimination from one test involves elimination from the whole competition. If equality exists, the classification is decided by the best dressage score. If equality still exists, the closest to optimum time (under the time set) in the jumping test determines the result.
11. Fall of Horse or Rider in any phase incurs elimination.
12. Error penalties incurred in the Dressage Test will be as follows

1st time	Two (2) points
2nd time	Four (4) points
3rd time	Elimination
Other errors:	Two (2) points per error to be deducted

13. Once competitor's dressage percentage score is calculated, it will be converted into a penalty score as per EA Eventing Rules. ie $100 \text{ minus "dressage \% score"} = \text{penalty}$ (this figure is to be rounded to 1 decimal digit)
14. Showjumping Penalties are as follows:

Knocking down an obstacle	4 penalties
First run-out, refusal or unauthorised circle in the whole test	4 penalties
Second run-out, refusal or unauthorised circle in the whole test	8 penalties
Third run-out, refusal or unauthorised circle in the whole test	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination

Time Faults: The length of the course and the speed demanded determine the time allowed.

Completing the course in less than the time allowed is not rewarded, but exceeding the time allowed is penalised by one penalty for each commenced second in excess of the time allowed, up to the time limit, which is twice the time allowed. Exceeded the time limit involves elimination.

15. Neither the Organising Committee of any event to which these rules apply nor Equestrian Australia accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
16. Any changes to this programme or the rules within is at the discretion of the organising committee and may be done so without notice to competitors.
