DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS

OPTIMUM TIME – run under Table A: The rider endeavours to ride the course according to how the judge has measured the course and speed it should be ridden at. The rider closest to the time with the least amount of faults is the winner. The overall rider closest to the optimum time will win the trophy rug for that class

AM7 – ART 238.2.2 & 245.3: The rider endeavours to ride the course according to how the judge has measured the course and speed it should be ridden at. If the rider jumps the course without error or time faults, they then go into an immediate jump off that is timed and may include a new jump. Riders are placed according to time and faults in the jump off.

OTT: This class is for OTT thoroughbreds and Standardbreds. This class will be included in every competition height. If you nominate to do a class and own an OTT, you will automatically go into this class. Ribbons will be awarded 1st – 6th as well as points which will be tallied and the rider with the most points at the end of the day will win the woollen rug for best performed OTT of the day.

Training Rounds

Training rounds will commence at 8am. All rider/horse combinations must complete competition rounds first. If a training round is done prior to a competition round, the competition rounds after are non-competitive.

- **PLEASE NOTE RIDERS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO ENTER 3 ROUNDS OVER 3 CONSECUTIVE HEIGHTS IN EACH RING**
- Riders are permitted to wear hacking jacket or official pony club uniform
- Classes will be broken into 3 groups: Rider 13 yrs and under, Rider 14 yrs up to and including 25 yrs and rider over 25 yrs. Ribbons awarded up to 6th place
- Ribbons and rugs can be collected from the club room after results are announced.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Ring will be open for walking before start time

Courses will be open for walking after each height change

EA rules apply for this event

Horse and rider combinations can enter maximum 3 rounds over 3 consecutive heights in each ring

Training rounds must be entered on the day in the office

Ground fee is per horse

Horse and rider combinations can enter a class twice, but the second round and all rounds after that will be training rounds

Horsepower Australia retains the right to change the program at any time or reschedule the event

Every rider must first register before mounting
