- 1. <u>Modern Pentathlon (UIPM): Swim, Fence, Show Jump (Pool Horse), Laser Run</u> (Run/Shoot) \$185
- 1b. As above but riding Your Own Horse for a 30 point deduction \$135
- 2. <u>Tetrathlon (Pony Club Style): Swim, Shoot (10m Laser Pistols [7m for</u> <u>12&U]), Jumping Hickstead/Derby style Course (Own Horse), Run</u> \$90
- 3. Tetrathlon (UIPM): Swim, Fence, Laser Run (Run/Shoot) \$80
- 4. Triathle A: Fence (Epee), Laser Run (Run/Shoot) \$60
- 5. Triathle B: Swim, LaserRun (Run/Shoot) \$60
- 6. Fence: Epee (One Touch) \$30
- 7. Laser Run: Run/Shoot \$40
