CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all competitors, whether actually engaged in any event or not, do so at their own risk and will indemnify and save harmless the organizing club, committee members and members from all claims, actions, suits or demands arising out of injury, personal or otherwise caused out of their presence at this show. **Disclaimer Statement forms to be completed and sent back with prepaid entries.**

The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner.

The committee reserves the right to alter the program without prior notice. Strictly no refunds will be issued.

ASA approved hard hats must be worn at all times, whilst mounted.

Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced.

Stallions are to be bitted at all times and must be under the supervision of a person over 18 years of age.

The Judge's decision is final.

Ridden Classes:

Horses/riders that are placed 1st in their classes are to present for the judging of the Championship and Reserve Championship awards. Any rider that comes 2nd to the Champion is eligible to contest for Reserve Champion.

Presentation:

All horses ARE NOT BE PLAITED. All horses must be neat and clean and no paddock halters or lead ropes are permitted.

Handler –

- Halter – Neat pants (no jeans allowed) and dress shirt. Jacket, hat and gloves are recommended but optional. Suitable footwear (no joggers/open shoes) must be worn. Whip optional for mares and geldings but compulsory for colts and stallions.
- Ridden – Matchy Matchy attire is encouraged! However safety comes first so you must wear an approved helmet, riding boots and the appropriate riding clothing. No private logos or individual sponsor's equipment or clothing to be used. SPPHAWA and Off the Track WA attire is more than acceptable. NO ear bonnets, boots or bandages to be worn.

Ridden Classifications & Rulings

The Elementary Hack section is for Walk/Trot horses. Alternatively you may decide to not compete in the elementary classes and take the option to earn points by competing in the Intermediate or Open classes. You will be required to do set workouts and canter on both reins with advanced transitions. If you have any queries please contact Kristie.

Elementary Hack classes (Walk & Trot) – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. If competing in this section you cannot compete in the Intermediate/Open classes. **Once you compete in any 'canter' class you will no longer be eligible for these classes. The Have a Canter classes are excluded from this.**

Intermediate Hack (SPPHAWA Grading) – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. Horses will earn points for the Intermediate Hack awards only. This section still requires canter but you are not competing against Open horses. If competing in Intermediate classes you can also compete in the Open Smartest on Parade and Rider classes but not in the Open Hack classes.

Show Horse/Show Hunter – You can only compete in one class not both. As it is only one class at this show you will be expected to work like a hunter however the full attire (plain browband/Jacket) is not compulsory.

Description of Activities¹: Any equestrian event that is run by SPPHAWA

Risk Warning

I am aware that by my participation in any activities arranged by the Provider, certain risks or dangers may occur which could include:

- Physical, bodily or psychological injury or death.
- Physical exertion to which I am not accustomed.
- Failure of equipment or use of inadequate equipment.
- There may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport to treatment if I am injured.
- The conditions in which the activities are conducted may vary without warning.
- I may cause injury to other persons and/or other persons may cause injury to me.
- I may be injured or die due to the negligence, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty or guarantee of the provider.

I acknowledge that the activities are being undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure, and involve a significant degree of risk of physical harm.

I acknowledge that the Activity may be undertaken with one or more other persons as part of a group and that the Provider is not liable for the actions of other participants in the group activity.

By signing below, I acknowledge, agree and understand that the risks associated with the Activities and/or recreational services have been explained to me. I undertake any such risk voluntarily and at my own risk.

I acknowledge that the risk warning above constitutes a "risk warning" in accordance with the *Civil Liability Act 2002 (NSW)* and the *Civil Liability Act 2002 (WA)*.

Participant's Warranties

I agree to abide by any of the Provider's rules, and any direction or instruction given to me by the Provider during the course of the Activities. I agree to use and/or wear any equipment given to me by the Provider.

I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Activities. I acknowledge that I must, and agree that I will, disclose any pre-existing medical or other condition, injury or concern that may affect the risk that either I or any other person will suffer injury, loss or damage during the course of the Activities and notify the Provider of any injuries, illness or concerns that may arise during the Activity. I will not engage in any reckless, negligent or foolish behaviour or any other behaviour that is likely to cause injury to me, any other participant or person.

I agree that if I suffer any injury or illness, the Provider may provide evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment at my expense and that my acceptance of these terms and conditions constitutes my consent to such evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment.

I declare that I have not consumed any alcohol or mind altering substance, or medication that may impact my judgement or physical capacity, before or at the time of engaging in the Activities.

Exclusion of liability

I agree to and unconditionally release, waive, discharge and forever hold harmless, the Provider or any of its employees, agents, directors or officers, from any claims as a result of any personal injury sustained, whether caused by the Provider's negligent act or wilful act or omission, breach of contract, breach of statutory duty, error, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of the Activities.

Waiver

Covid-19 Information

Please do not come to the show if you are unwell or are showing flu-like symptoms.

Social distancing

A distance of 2m² between people should be maintained at all times. This includes the car park, warm up ring and judging arenas. SPPHAWA will have designated points where hand sanitiser is available, however competitors should also practice safe hygiene measures and have their own hand sanitiser to use throughout the day and after visiting communal areas.

Spectators

There will be a limit of 2 helpers, strappers or supporters per rider. Their names and contact numbers must be listed on the entry form in the 'Additional Person' section.

Float parking

To maintain the Federal Government's social distancing measure of 2m², a suggested minimum distance of 5m between floats should be maintained.

Yards

Being 'shared equipment' communal yards can be used with social distancing and hygiene measures in place. To maintain the Federal Government's social distancing measure of 2m², there should be a minimum of 2 yard widths between each participant (i.e. – every third yard to be used). Where a rider has more than one horse, these can be yarded next to one another with the 2 yard width observed beyond this.

Wash Bays

The wash bay will be open for use however there will be a limit of 1 horse to be washed at all times.

Venue facilities (canteen & club rooms)

Will not be available at this event. Please ensure you bring enough food and drink for yourself.

Toilets

Toilet facilities can be accessed with hygiene measures in place, however will be limited to 1 person at a time. Anti-bacterial hand wash and sanitiser will be provided and must be used after each visit. At this stage, toilets cannot be used as change rooms so please use alternative arrangements.

State and Federal health advice must be followed AT ALL TIMES. This includes the necessary social distancing and hygiene protocols plus remaining at home if any COVID-19 symptoms are present.
