Conditions of Entry.

- ABOSLUTEY NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS
- All riders must provide a helper or self-help without exception. Helpers must be 16yrs or older. Limited self-help available on a first in best dressed basis. Please SMS requests 0455667898
- YOU CANNOT LIST ANOTHER RIDER AS YOUR HELPER. Riders riding two horses will be given either 2 jobs or an extended helper job
- All Riders must be 2020 financial members of PCWA. Membership cards must be supplied upon arrival before you begin riding.
- The competition will be run under current rules for PCWA dressage including current gear checking. It is the responsibility of riders to know what these rules are. Rules are freely accessible via the PCWA website.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program or refuse entry. Entrants must adhere to the PC Codes of Conduct.
- Neither the organising committee nor the affiliated bodies to which the host club belongs accepts any liability for any accident, injury, damage or illness to horses, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- Refunds only given if scratching before closing date. After closing date refunds will only be given if the organiser is supplied with a doctors or vet certificate.
- There are several day yards for horses. These come on a first come first served basis
- Canteen will be open on the day to purchase pre-packaged foods and drinks only
- Manure can be scattered across the grounds. DO NOT leave manure around the trees
- Riders must be dressed in full pony club uniform or tie and jackets for open riders. Must have long sleeves.
- Full payment to be made before close of entries.
- Ages as of 1/1/2020
- The lead line test will be ridden at the conclusion of other tests. Riders in the lead line may not ride in any other tests. The riders must be accompanied by a helper over the age of 16 in the arena at all times either leading or running next to the pony. Riders must be dressed in pony club uniform – rally shirts are allowed. No plaiting is required. Riders must be 10 or under as of the 1/1/2020
- Freestyle music to be emailed to georgia19v@hotmail.com by Friday 24th July. Riders must also bring a copy of their music to the event- format to be advised.

COVID 19 Regulations

- All riders must present to gear check with a helper on the ground if possible. The gear checker will guide this person through the gear checking process.
- There will be hand sanitisers located at various locations around the grounds, including at the front gate, on the water taps and in commonly touched areas. We ask that everyone please use these.
- The canteen will be open but will only serve pre-packaged foods and drinks. We ask everyone to try and bring the correct change to minimise the handling of money.
- We have a COVID 19 safety plan in place.
- We will be abiding by the 2 sq. metre rule per person and the 1.5m social distancing rule, please abide by these rules to ensure everyone is safe.
- Please do not attend the event if you are unwell
- Please limit the number of helpers you bring with you, this with help to minimise contact
