Gates Open 6.30am.

Show Jumping Courses open for walking 8am, starting 9am

Dressage Tests starting 8am.

A helper is required per horse, limited self-help available if arranged with organiser on entry.

Show Jumping and Dressage will be run separately for PCWA and Open.

The classes marked with an * will eligible for PCWA leader board points.

You may enter a maximum of 3 show jumping rounds across 2 consecutive heights and a maximum of 3 dressage tests.

Riders competing in other individual classes may nominate their individual score to the Combined Training TEAM as either the dressage or jumping rider – They only ride once but the score contributed to both the individual and team classes.

Riding Fees

- \$17.50 – per Show Jumping Round
- \$27.50 – per Dressage test
- \$10.00 – per Combined Training team rider

Other Fees

- \$10 per horse Ground fee is required.
- \$30 Helper Bond is Required – **This will be refunded in CASH on the completion of Helper duty. All bonds must be collected on the day.**
- \$10 First Aid levy required for all riders

Information & Rules (please read carefully):

Refunds

- A refund of entry will be provided less \$10 administration fee with submission of a veterinary or doctor's certificate within 7 days of completion of the event.
- Scratching's after the release of helper duty list: Helper duty bonds will not be refunded unless helper duty is completed or other arrangement are made with Organising Committee

Membership

- All riders will be required to present proof of membership/insurance on registration.
- **No day insurance is available.**
- EA insurance will **not** cover you for this event.
- To ride in PCWA classes, riders must be financially ordinary or associate members of an affiliated pony club.
- To ride in Open Classes, riders must be 18yrs+ and hold PCWA open rider membership, mounted coach, mounted adult supporter or affiliate rider membership with a PCWA affiliated club or hold a competition licence with PCWA.

Helpers

- **All riders are required to nominate a helper per horse.** There is limited self-help available and **only** when organised with event organisers prior to entry. Failure to provide a helper will result in elimination from competition.
 - o **Riders must not nominate another riders as their helper.**

Gear Checking/ Presentation

- Formal PC uniform and presentation is required. Horses must be presented formally as per PCWA gear checking for PCWA dressage and show jumping.

- Open riders must ride in attire as outlined in PCWA Gear Checking manual as per Open Rider requirements. Horses must be presented formally as per PCWA gear checking for PCWA dressage and show jumping.
- PCWA gear checking rules will be enforced.
- Body protectors are recommended to be worn for show jumping classes.

- **No stallions** permitted on Walliston Riding & Pony Club grounds.
- **No dogs** will be allowed on the grounds.
- Limited yards are available to use on a first in best dressed basis.
- A canteen will be available.
- No rider under 18 years of age is to be left on the grounds without a parent/guardian.
- Please leave the grounds as you found them, pick up horse's manure and hay and dispose of it at the manure pit found behind the stables, **not** at base of trees!

Walliston Riding & Pony club retains the right to:

- **Cancel any class or event.**
- **Change the program at any time or reschedule any event.**
- **Alter the advertised times.**
- **Refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.**

Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor Pony Club Western Australia accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

Combined Training TEAMS classes information:

- A Combined Training competition comprises of 'two of the three tests of a horse trial'.
- The dressage and jumping tests, which make up the combined training competition, must be taken in that order (dressage followed by show jumping).
- The scores from both tests will be combined for an overall final penalty score with the lowest penalty score being the winner of the class.
- Combined Training classes will be run based on the 2016 Pony Club Victoria Rules for Combined Training.
- Dressage scores will be scored as per eventing dressage resulting in a final penalty score.
- Dressage will be judged under PCWA eventing dressage rules except –
 - Half or whole marks may be awarded for individual movements and collective marks.
- Show jumping will consist of one (1) round judged under PCWA show jumping rules except –
 - *The show jumping test is similar to an ordinary Show Jumping Competition, but without any attempt to find a 'winner' of this test on its own. Its main objective is to prove that, the horse and rider are well trained in the specialist discipline of show jumping. It is also to prove that, after a test of endurance, the horses have retained the suppleness, energy and obedience necessary for them to perform.*

- Elimination from one phase constitutes elimination from the class.
- **One combined training class per horse and rider combination per day.**

Walliston RPC Extravaganza Series Prizes

Must compete in a minimum of 2 events to be eligible.

This will be scored using points system based on class placings

1st = 7

2nd = 6

3rd = 5

4th = 4

5th = 3

6th = 2

Participation = 1

Individual Series Classes

- **12yrs & under**
- **13 -16 years**
- **17 & Over**
- **Open**

This year we will be running an overall series according to age group rather than each class.

Only scores from Dressage and show jumping classes are eligible – Combined training classes do not count toward individual series.

TEAMS Series Classes

- **40cm & Prep**
- **60cm & Prelim**
- **80cm & Novice**

Team members must remain the same throughout all events

In the case of a draw – the higher dressage score will be used to determine placings
