The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner.

#### STRICTLY NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.

ASA approved hard hats must be worn at all times, whilst mounted.

Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced.

Stallions are to be bitted at all times and must be under the supervision of a person over 18 years of age. The Judge's decision is final.

#### **Ridden Classes:**

Horses/riders that are placed 1<sup>st</sup> in their classes are to present for the judging of the Championship and Reserve Championship awards. Any rider that comes 2<sup>nd</sup> to the Champion is eligible to contest for Reserve Champion.

#### **Presentation:**

Horses CAN BE PLAITED or UNPLAITED. Horses must be neat and clean and no paddock halters or lead ropes are permitted.

#### Handler -

- Halter Neat pants (no jeans allowed) and dress shirt. Jacket, hat and gloves are recommended but optional. Suitable dress or skirt that is at least knee length and has a cap sleeve. Suitable footwear (no joggers/open shoes) must be worn. Whip optional for mares and geldings but compulsory for colts and stallions.
- Ridden Traditional ridden attire, show shirt with short or long sleeves but vest and jackets are
  optional. Traditional light coloured jodhpur's must be worn. You must wear an approved helmet,
  and riding boots.

#### **Ridden Classifications & Rulings**

All horses who have yet to compete under saddle are graded as Elementary. Alternatively, you may decide to not compete in the elementary classes and take the option to earn points by competing in the Intermediate or Open classes. You will be required to do set workouts and canter on both reins with advanced transitions. If you have any queries please contact Kristie.

Elementary Hack classes (Walk & Trot) – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. If competing in this section you cannot compete in the Intermediate/Open classes. Once you compete in <a href="mailto:any-canter">any-canter</a> class you will no longer be eligible for these classes.

Have A Canter – these classes are for any Elementary graded horses to have the opportunity to have a canter in a show atmosphere. Horses who have graded out of Elementary and not yet competing in Intermediate are also eligible to compete in these classes until they compete in an Intermediate class. Horses will only do a simple workout and no class will be judged on the ring.

Intermediate Hack (SPPHAWA Grading) – These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. Horses will earn points for the Intermediate Hack awards only. This section still requires canter but you are not competing against Open horses. If competing in Intermediate classes you can also compete in the Open Smartest on Parade and Rider classes but not in the Open Hack classes.

**Show Horse/Show Hunter** – You can only compete in one class not both. As it is only one class at this show you will be expected to work like a hunter however the full attire (plain browband/Jacket) is not compulsory.
