No unruly behaviour will be **tolerated**! Leave your personal issues at the gate, just come along and have some fun and enjoy your horses.

If entries are low in certain breeds we may have to combine classes! So encourage people you know with heavy horses to please attend.

Halter Information

Stallions and Colts must have suitable and substantial headgear with bit, as per breed standard. The age of the handler must be 18 years of age or over. All horses that enter the led classes must be registered with the relevant breed society. Please provide a copy of the **registration papers** with your entry.

Ridden

Approved safety helmets must be worn by all riders.

Harness Information

Please bring with you your chains or leather traces of minimum length 2340mm (2.34 m). Also check that your hooks can fit over 10 mm steel. No carabineers or closable clips allowed, you MUST use hooks. ALL horses must be bitted.

Novice refers to handler who has not won a class at a harness show.

Open refers to a handler that has won a novice, intermediate or open class.

Maiden refers to horse that has never won a class at a harness show.

The Harness classes are open to registered & unregistered heavy horses.

Protests

Formal written & signed Protests to be submitted within 30 minutes from the conclusion of the event, with a \$50.00 fee (non-refundable). Ground Jury decision will be final and cannot be protested.

The Judge's decision is **FINAL**.

Points will only be collated from selected classes. If people compete in Beginner, Novice and Open then the highest winning points will be taken from only 1 class.

Junior driver

Under 18 years old. Horse must be driven in long reins.

Beginner Driver

Driver never won a novice event at a working show; horse must be driven in long reins.

Novice Driver

Driver never won an open event at a working show; horse must be driven in long reins.

Open Driver

Horse must be driven in long reins.

Maiden Horse

Horse has never won a first place at a working show. Horse must be driven in long reins.

Novice Horse

Horse has never won a Maiden class at a working show. Horse must be driven in long reins.

Open Horse

Horse must be driven in long reins.

Obstacle Driven

Must be driven in long lines, timed event. The obstacle course will be set up on the day. Judged on each obstacle and timed event.

Log Snig

Horse must be driven in long lines.

Drivers are not allowed to adjust, alter, assist the horse by moving harness or chains once course is started until horse and driver have finished the course.

Sled Obstacle Race

Collect the tennis balls going up and bend back through the cones coming back. Penalties apply for dropped balls and knocked cones.

Single Horse Wheeled Class

Single horse in wheeled vehicle.

Pairs Wheeled Class

Pairs in a wheeled vehicle.

Authentic Vehicle Class

Wooden wheeled vehicles.

Non-Authentic Class

All metal wheeled vehicles.

Trophy Presentations on main lawn

Ross Walmsley Trophy (formerly Doral Cup): Supreme Clydesdale winner.

Rex Newbold Perpetual Trophy: Clydesdale with the highest points from led and working classes. Same handler and horse. The judge will request a play off if any horse and handler finish in 1st equal place. Points from best presented (breed programme) are not included.

Walter Angel Perpetual Trophy: Working horse with most points from chained events. If tied, the judge will request a play off. Same horse and handler.

Duncan McKinnon Trophy: The same horse and handler with most points from all driven classes. If horse is entered in beginner, novice and open the only points awarded will be the highest from one class only.

Matilda Trophy: Part-Bred Clydesdale with the most points in show – Led and harness.

Tullymore Jeremy Award: The working Clydesdale gelding with the most points over the weekend.

Heavy Horse High Point Award: Awarded to the Heavy Horse (non-Clydesdale) with the most points over the weekend.
