 Hunter Trials riders may do 2 rounds at same height or at 2 consecutive heights.
 Tetrathlon riders may do one Hunter Trial round at the same height or one height higher than their Tetrathlon round.

TETRATHLON INDIVIDUAL CLASSES:

Classes are divided on Rider Age at the 1st January 2021. Riders select a jumping height they are competent at. Each class has a Standard Jump Height. A handicap of 50 points per 5cm is applied to the ride score for each 5cm the selected jumping height is below the standard height.

TETRATHLON PAIRS CLASSES

Classes are divided on Jumping Height. Each member of a pair must complete 2 of the 4 phases, 1 or both competitors may also compete as individuals and use the scores from 2 phases of their individual entry for their pair entry. The pair entry must specify which phases are to be used for each competitor.

HUNTER TRIALS CLASSES

One entry fee allows you to ride 2 cross country rounds, these can be at the same height or at 2 consecutive heights. Only the first round at any height is eligible for prizes. Tetrathlon competitors may pay an additional fee to ride a second round after their Tetrathlon Ride phase, this may be at the same height or one height higher than their Tetrathlon round.

Late entries may be accepted with a \$30 late fee (at discretion of the organising committee). Details of the draw (including helper duties) will be available on the cavaletti website and emailed to competitors if an email address is provided.

INSURANCE

All competitors that will be riding the cross country phase and under the age of 18 must be a current Pony Club WA member. Over 18 you must have Pony Club WA Open Rider insurance. If you are in a pair and not competing in the riding phase you are required to take out Pony Club WA day insurance for \$10.

LIABILITY

The Organising Committee of the Tetrathlon, Pony Club WA and the Dryandra Pony Club, or any person acting on their behalf, do not accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, competitors, spectators or any person or property whatsoever. All Competitors compete at their own risk.

FOOD

A full canteen service will be operating over the weekend; 9am to 7pm on Saturday and 7am to 3pm on Sunday. The coffee machine will be operating in the canteen all weekend. Saturday night meals can be booked with your entry, \$15 includes lasagne, chips and salad (meat or vegetarian options) and apple pie and custard.

ACCOMMODATION

Free camping is available at the Dryandra Regional Equestrian Park. Shower facilities are available at the grounds.

NOTES: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- The Tetrathlon phases will be run under Pony Club WA Tetrathlon Rules.
- The Hunter Trials will be run under Pony Club WA Hunter Trials Rules.
- Please be familiar with the rules as there are differences between the two disciplines in both penalties allowed on course and in gear checking. Current rules are available on the Pony Club WA website at <https://www.ponyclubwa.asn.au>.
- Open riders must adhere to the relevant Pony Club WA gear checking rules.
- Age for all classes is determined on age at 1st January 2021.
- All competitors must include either the Pony Club WA Member number or their current Annual Insurance number.
- Unmounted Competitors without Pony Club WA insurance must pay a \$10 day insurance and complete the attached form.
- All Competitors must sign one of the two Disclaimer forms attached either for Pony Club WA Members or for Non-Pony Club WA Members.
- Pairs may consist of either two adults or one adult and one junior or two juniors.
- One helper can do a maximum of 2 helper duties, limited self-help is available by prior arrangement with the Event Secretary.
- Bridle numbers, medical armbands and body protectors are compulsory.
- Each competitor must supply their own bib style number holder for all phases.
- A horse may only be ridden by 1 rider and may only complete a maximum of 2 rounds.
- Yards must be reserved for the weekend (\$25) by prior arrangement to laraskerritt@gmail.com. The yards are undercover and have a single chain as the 1.2m gate – additional rope to secure ponies is recommended.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter start times and or combine or cancel classes if numbers require.
- If this event is cancelled once competition is underway due to extreme weather, there will be a no refund policy.
- Dogs are **NOT** allowed at Dryandra Regional Equestrian Park during Pony Club events.

- A rider may attend a maximum of 2 Pony Club Rallies as a day member and will not be covered by any insurance unless a full riding member.
- As of 1st January 2013 Day Membership is not allowed at any Pony Club WA Open event or competition (excluding unmounted phase for Tetrathlon).
