PAIRS:

Each member of a pair must complete 2 of the 4 phases, 1 or both competitors may also compete as individuals and use the scores from 2 phases of their individual entry for their pair entry. The pair entry must specify which phases are to be used for each competitor. If the non riding member of the pair is not a PCWA member then they must take out PCWA day insurance for \$10 and complete the PCWA Disclaimer.

NOTE:

This event will be run under PCWA Tetrathalon Rules. Riding phase to be in Pony Club cross country uniform or Open Riders in long sleeved shirt, white/beige jodphurs, approved boots and helmet. Pony Club gear checking will be enforced for all classes. All members must provide a helper over the age of 16.

INSURANCE:

All competitors that will be riding the cross country phase and under the age of 18 must be a current PCWA member. Over 18 you must have PCWA Open Rider Insurance. If you are in a pair and not competing in the riding phase you are required to take out PCWA day insurance for \$10 and must complete the PCWA Disclaimer.

LIABILITY:

The Organising Committee of the Tetrathalon, Pony Club WA and Wallangarra Pony Club or any person acting on their behalf, do not accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, competitors, spectators or any person or property whatsoever. All Competitors compete at their own risk.

CAMPING:

Camping is available at Wallangarra Pony Club. Depending on numbers it may be in the ten acres with water and toilet facilities. Please allow space to be COVID safe. Please indicate on your entry if you are camping.

FOOD:

A full canteen service will be operating over the weekend with drinks, meals and snacks available from 7am – 3pm on Saturday and Sunday. Evening meals – grounds are in close proximity to Byford and Armadale – lots of food venues to choose from.

OPEN (SOCIAL CLASSES):

The open or social classes are for 18 and over. The run is 1km and the swim is 100m.

NOTES: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Pairs may consist of either two adults or one adult and one junior or two juniors.
- All competitors must include either PCWA Member number or non-riding competitors may purchase a PCWA \$10 day membership.
- All competitors must sign the Disclaimer attached, including PCWA members.
- Every competitor must supply a helper. No competitor will be allowed to compete if an individual helper is not available.
- Current PCWA rules for tetrathalon and eventing apply. Please refer to pony club website.
- Medical armbands are compulsory for riding phase.
- All competitors must present to all phases with their bib style number holder.
- All competitors must wear a body protector for the cross country riding phase.
- Age for all classes is determined at 1st January 2021.
- Competitors must be at least 9 years old on 1st January 2021 to compete in any phase of the tetrathalon.
- Yards must be reserved for the weekend (\$15) by prior arrangement to <u>donna.black@me.com</u>.
 There are limited yards available.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter start times. Please check Wallangarra Riding and Pony Club Facebook page for current information.
- Horses may only jump one height One horse one rider rule applies for all classes.
- Competitors competing as a pair and an individual must do so in the same grade.
- Minimum age for horses is 4 years.
- If this event is cancelled once competition is underway due to extreme weather, there will be a no refund policy.
- Please include swim times on entry form to assist with scheduling heats.
