CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all competitors, whether actually engaged in any event or not, do so at their own risk and will indemnify and save harmless the organizing club, committee members and members from all claims, actions, suits or demands arising out of injury, personal or otherwise caused out of their presence at this show. **Disclaimer Statement forms to be completed and sent back with prepaid entries (Non Members only)**

The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner. Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced. IT IS UP TO EACH EXHIBITOR TO ONLY TAKE HORSES THAT ARE IN GOOD HEALTH.

Strictly no refunds unless this event is cancelled due to COVID restrictions.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ALTER THE PROGRAM WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE

Led Presentation- All horses must be presented in a show bridle with reins or lead and a show slip for juniors. Halters are not permitted for led classes. Colts/Stallions may be left with a flowing mane and tail. Race Conditioned and Junior horses likewise are not required to be plaited. Mares and geldings must have plaited/hog manes with tails plaited, shaved or pulled. Stallions must be bitted and handler carry a whip at all times. **No junior is permitted to ride, handle or be responsible for the care of an entire horse.**

All handlers must have suitable enclosed footwear- No open toes, sandals, slingback shoes or joggers are permitted. Shoes must have the top of the foot covered (e.g., no ballet flats)

Ridden Presentation of Horse & Rider- Horse presentation is that of Led horses, with the exception that **all horses** must be plaited. Jacket, stock/tie, vest, breeches, boots, gloves should be clean and colour coordinated to match horse. Helmets must be approved and not expired. Junior riders are not permitted to use long boots in their rider classes.

Ridden Classifications & Rulings for Standardbreds

Elementary Hack classes (Walk & Trot): These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. If competing in this section you cannot compete in the Intermediate/Open classes. **Alternatively, once you win 2 Champions after your first 12 months in the grade or compete in any 'canter' class you will no longer be eligible for these classes. (Dressage, Eventing and outside canter events are included in this). The Have a Canter classes are excluded from this.**

If any Walk/Trot graded horses choose to compete in any canter classes (excluding the 'have a go canter classes' listed in the Walk/Trot ring) they will not be eligible to drop back to Walk/Trot. A judge has the right to ask an exhibit to leave the ring if deemed to be working in an unacceptable manner.

^ NEWCOMER HACK – this class is for any horse that has not competed in any ridden classes prior to June 27th, 2020. This means they are in their first 12 months of competition. Any horse that has competed prior to June 27th 2020 is not eligible for this class.

Intermediate Hack (SPPHAWA Grading): These classes are for SPPHAWA assessed horses and any non-member who would like to compete. This section requires canter, but you are not competing against Open horses. If competing in Intermediate classes you can also compete in the Open Smartest on Parade and Rider classes but not in the Open Hack classes. **Double bridles are not permitted in this grade.**

Open Ridden Classes:

Only for horses that are assessed & graded by SPPHAWA as an Open horse. Open horses need to have an acceptable level of training to walk, trot and canter in a rounded frame on a circle and in an individual workout. The horse must also demonstrate clean transitions in all of its work and obedience to the rider.

Show Hack/Show Hunter – You can only compete in one class not both. As it is only one class at this show you will be expected to work like a hunter however the full attire (plain browband/jacket) is not compulsory.

Race Conditioned- Standardbreds must have raced within a 28 day period & Thoroughbreds within a 42 day period- proof must be provided with entry. If you enter RaceConditioned you cannot enter the Stallion, Mare or Gelding sections.

Maiden Horse - open to any horse that has not won a first place in a led class. Race Conditioned horses are also eligible to compete.

Track to Hack- These classes are for horses who have raced or trialled in their lifetime. Proof will be required with entry. A race history can be obtained from the HRA Website or Racing Australia.

The following pages affect your legal rights and obligations. Please read these carefully and only sign if you fully understand their contents. For Participants under 18 years of age, these documents must be completed by a parent or legal guardian.

Description of Activities¹: Any equestrian event that is run by SPPhAWA

Risk Warning

I am aware that by my participation in any activities arranged by the Provider, certain risks or dangers may occur which could include:

- Physical, bodily or psychological injury or death.
- Physical exertion to which I am not accustomed.
- Failure of equipment or use of inadequate equipment.
- There may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport to treatment if I am injured.
- The conditions in which the activities are conducted may vary without warning.
- I may cause injury to other persons and/or other persons may cause injury to me.
- I may be injured or die due to the negligence, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty or guarantee of the provider.

I acknowledge that the activities are being undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure, and involve a significant degree of risk of physical harm.

I acknowledge that the Activity may be undertaken with one or more other persons as part of a group and that the Provider is not liable for the actions of other participants in the group activity.

By signing below, I acknowledge, agree and understand that the risks associated with the Activities and/or recreational services have been explained to me. I undertake any such risk voluntarily and at my own risk.

I acknowledge that the risk warning above constitutes a “risk warning” in accordance with the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (NSW) and the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (WA).

Participant’s Warranties

I agree to abide by any of the Provider’s rules, and any direction or instruction given to me by the Provider during the course of the Activities. I agree to use and/or wear any equipment given to me by the Provider.

I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Activities. I acknowledge that I must, and agree that I will, disclose any pre-existing medical or other condition, injury or concern that may affect the risk that either I or any other person will suffer injury, loss or damage during the course of the Activities and notify the Provider of any injuries, illness or concerns that may arise during the Activity. I will not engage in any reckless, negligent or foolish behaviour or any other behaviour that is likely to cause injury to me, any other participant or person.

I agree that if I suffer any injury or illness, the Provider may provide evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment at my expense and that my acceptance of these terms and conditions constitutes my consent to such evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment.

I declare that I have not consumed any alcohol or mind altering substance, or medication that may impact my judgement or physical capacity, before or at the time of engaging in the Activities.

Exclusion of liability

I agree to and unconditionally release, waive, discharge and forever hold harmless, the Provider or any of its employees, agents, directors or officers, from any claims as a result of any personal injury sustained, whether caused by the Provider’s negligent act or wilful act or omission, breach of contract, breach of statutory duty, error, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of the Activities.

I agree that the Provider will not be liable for any claims for personal injury that may be brought against it as a result of or in connection with any act, omission, default, failure or error on the part of the Provider, and agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the Provider in respect of any such claims.

Waiver
