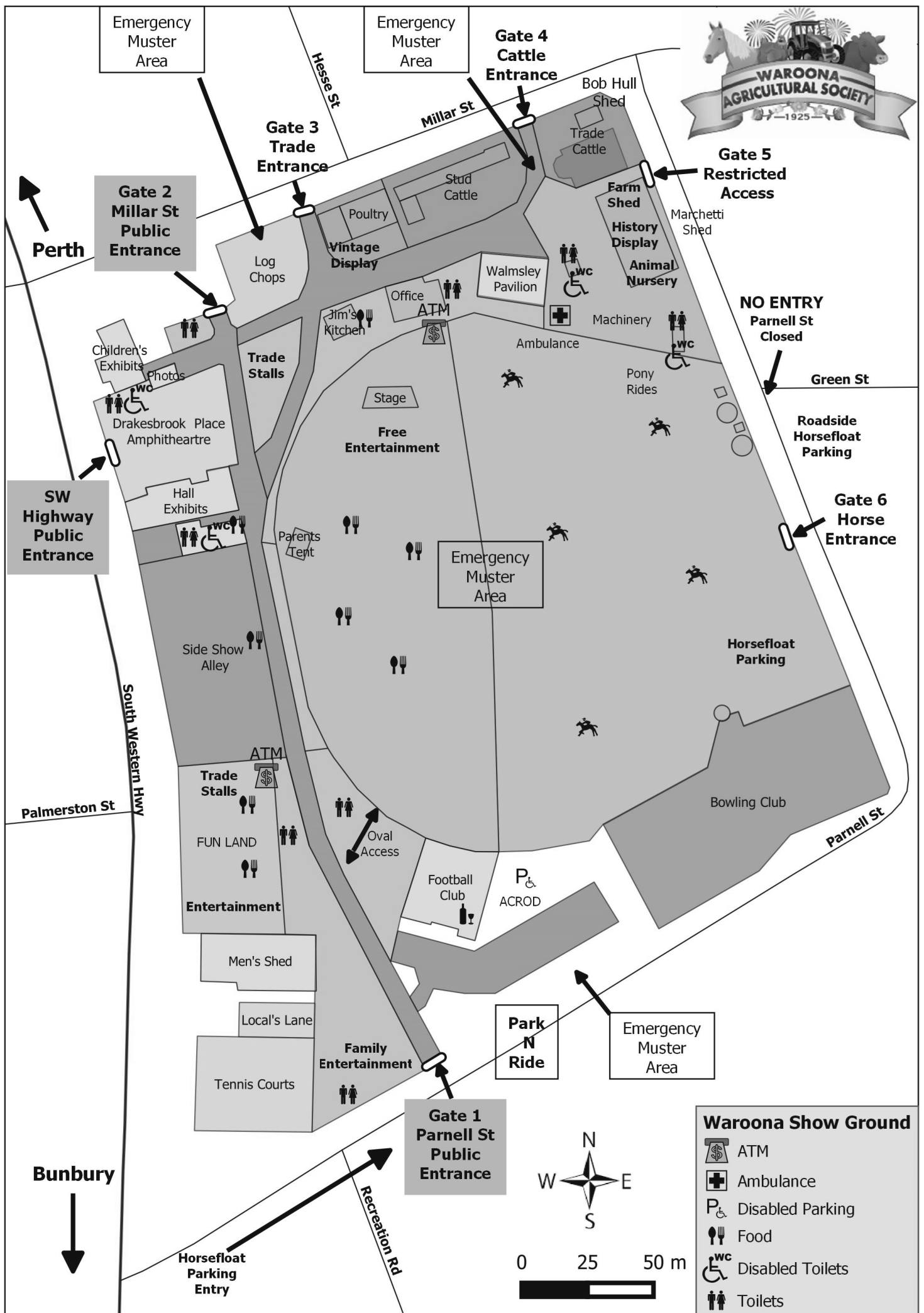

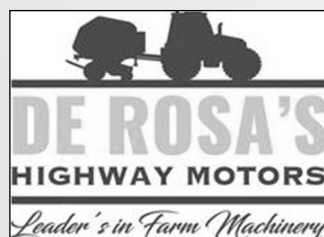

One of them starts to boast about his track record. "In the last 15 races, I've won eight of them!"

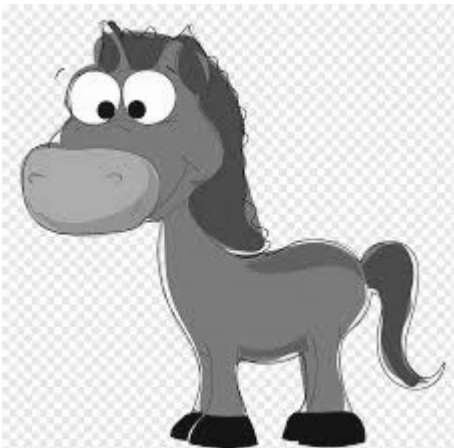
Another horse breaks in: "Well in the last 27 races, I've won 19!"
