8. One helper may do a maximum of 2 helper duties. No self help is available.
9. Age for all classes is determined on age at 1st January 2021.
10. Competitors must be at least 8 years old as at 1st of January 2021 to compete in any phase of the Tetrathlon.
11. Competitors must be at least 6 years old as at 1st of January 2021 to compete in any phase of the **Equathon**.
12. The organising committee reserves the right to alter start times and/or combine or cancel classes depending on numbers after the closing date.
13. If this event is cancelled once competition is underway due to extreme weather, there will be a no refund policy.
14. The one horse, one rider rule will apply for all classes.
15. Pairs may consist of either two adult riders or one adult and one junior or two juniors. **NO PAIRS COMPETITION AVAILABLE FOR THE EQUATHON.**
16. Dogs are NOT allowed at the Swan Valley Horse and Pony Club.
17. All current COVID-19 safety measures will be enforced.
