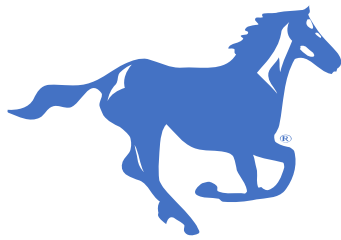

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The organising Committee of SPPHAWA, judges, officials, do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk.
- The Committee of SPPHAWA Inc reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event(s) they deem necessary on the day.
- The Committee have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner. All competitors must be a member of SPPHAWA, PCAWA or EA for insurance purposes to compete or ride on the grounds. Day membership is available for any competitor who is not a member. All Non-Members (of SPPHAWA) MUST complete the Day Membership Form and send with their entries.
- Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the show.
- Judges must not be approached under any circumstances by any competitor or spectator.
- Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced. The Judge's decision is final.
- Non participation in an event will not warrant a refund of any monies. A strict NO REFUND policy applies.
- This event is open to **unofficial horses only**. Any horse/pony who has competed official in the past 24 months cannot enter.
- Official riders must not enter rider classes.**
- **STALLIONS** are permitted to enter, however must display a green disc at all times. Any unruly or undesirable behaviour will result in the horse being asked to leave the grounds/event. All riders of stallions must be 18yrs or over.
- All ponies can be ridden by any age rider unless stated otherwise.
- A rider's age will be determined as at the day of event (proof of age may be requested)
- Lead Rein: riders must be 12yrs & under and ponies/horses up to & incl 15hh only.
- Current height certificates are not compulsory however horses are to compete in the correct height class.
- All horses/ponies are to wear snaffle bridles in Walk/Trot classes – double bridles will be permitted in Canter classes.
- All persons on horseback are required to wear an approved helmet meeting current safety standards and have a manufacture date prior to 5yrs.
- Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered.
- Please take all rubbish home with you and leave the grounds neat and tidy at the end of the day.
- In the event of Government restrictions preventing this event from running, a full refund of entries will be given.
- **Horses can only compete in one section – Walk/Trot or Walk/Trot Canter. Walk/Trot classes are strictly for horses that have not competed in any canter classes (this includes dressage and eventing).**
- **You may only enter ONE section – Show Hack OR Show Hunter, not both! If you enter & pay both there be will no refund.**
- Please list all classes you are entering on the entry form. Ensure all forms are completed correctly and submitted with your entries, including current membership cards.
- **NEWCOMER CLASSES:** only for horses who have not competed prior to 01/01/2021
- **PONY CLUB RIDER CLASSES:** for horses/ponies with a current Pony Club member rider. Proof of membership must be included with entry. **NO PONY CLUB OPEN RIDERS ELIGIBLE**
- **ADULT RIDER CLASSES:** for horse/ponies with a current Adult Rider member rider. Proof of membership must be included with entry.
- **FALLS:** a rider must not remount until they have been assessed by the First Aid Officer
- **PRE ENTRY:** this event is Pre-Entry only, no late entries or on the day entries will be accepted. Entries close Friday 29th October

Presentation:

- All ridden horses must be presented neat and clean. Gear should be clean and fit correctly.
- Horses/Ponies must be plaited (Lead Rein is optional)
- Riders to be presented in full show ring riding attire.
- Pony Club and Adult Rider mounts are permitted to ride in PC or Adult Rider uniform.
- Competitor Numbers will be provided, number holders are preferred but not essential.
- Whisker removal is optional

Description of Activities¹: Any equestrian event that is run by SPPHAWA

Risk Warning

I am aware that by my participation in any activities arranged by the Provider, certain risks or dangers may occur which could include:

- Physical, bodily or psychological injury or death.
- Physical exertion to which I am not accustomed.
- Failure of equipment or use of inadequate equipment.
- There may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport to treatment if I am injured.
- The conditions in which the activities are conducted may vary without warning.
- I may cause injury to other persons and/or other persons may cause injury to me.
- I may be injured or die due to the negligence, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty or guarantee of the provider.

I acknowledge that the activities are being undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure, and involve a significant degree of risk of physical harm.

I acknowledge that the Activity may be undertaken with one or more other persons as part of a group and that the Provider is not liable for the actions of other participants in the group activity.

By signing below, I acknowledge, agree and understand that the risks associated with the Activities and/or recreational services have been explained to me. I undertake any such risk voluntarily and at my own risk.

I acknowledge that the risk warning above constitutes a “risk warning” in accordance with the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (NSW) and the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (WA).

Participant’s Warranties

I agree to abide by any of the Provider’s rules, and any direction or instruction given to me by the Provider during the course of the Activities. I agree to use and/or wear any equipment given to me by the Provider.

I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Activities. I acknowledge that I must, and agree that I will, disclose any pre-existing medical or other condition, injury or concern that may affect the risk that either I or any other person will suffer injury, loss or damage during the course of the Activities and notify the Provider of any injuries, illness or concerns that may arise during the Activity. I will not engage in any reckless, negligent or foolish behaviour or any other behaviour that is likely to cause injury to me, any other participant or person.

I agree that if I suffer any injury or illness, the Provider may provide evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment at my expense and that my acceptance of these terms and conditions constitutes my consent to such evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment.

I declare that I have not consumed any alcohol or mind altering substance, or medication that may impact my judgement or physical capacity, before or at the time of engaging in the Activities.

Exclusion of liability

I agree to and unconditionally release, waive, discharge and forever hold harmless, the Provider or any of its employees, agents, directors or officers, from any claims as a result of any personal injury sustained, whether caused by the Provider’s negligent act or wilful act or omission, breach of contract, breach of statutory duty, error, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of the Activities.

I agree that the Provider will not be liable for any claims for personal injury that may be brought against it as a result of or in connection with any act, omission, default, failure or error on the part of the Provider, and agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the Provider in respect of any such claims.

Waiver
