CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **No Hay is permitted outside of horse floats or trucks – Council Regulation**
2. **Please take all Rubbish and Manure with you. Rubbish bags are available from the Nominations Office – Council Regulation.**
3. The committee of Perth Horse and Pony Club Inc. (PH&PC) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event/s they may deem necessary
4. The grounds are public open space and cannot be sealed from public access. All entrants must sign the declaration when picking up numbers or they will NOT be allowed to compete.
5. All competitors must be a member of either EWA, SHCWA, PCAWA or Perth Horse and Pony Club for insurance purposes to compete/ride on the grounds. Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered. An insurance levy and a disclaimer must be signed.
6. No plaiting or jackets are required for this event.. Neat tidy Attire, recognised standards approved helmet and boots are a condition of entry.
7. The judge's decision is final. Protests must be received in writing within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, with a \$100 fee attached – refund will only take place if the protest is upheld.
8. Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Officials and fellow competitors. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed for the class or disqualified from the Show. **BULLYING OF ANY DESCRIPTION WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**
9. The Committee reserves the right to expel a horse from the grounds if, in their opinion, a horses behaviour is considered to be unruly or intractable and/or which may pose a safety risk to itself, any other horse, or any person
10. It is always the responsibility of the rider/ competitor/ horse owner to ensure that the needs of their horse are being met appropriately, and that the rules of the sport and EA Code of Conduct are being followed at all times. A Horse Welfare Officer will be in attendance. Any person found to be causing undue distress towards their horse/s will be dealt with accordingly.
11. **Open to ALL ponies, horses & riders. Tractable stallions welcome.**
12. Ponies or horses/rider combinations that have competed in the Official ring in the past 12 months, cannot compete in the Encouragement or Unofficial ring.
13. Rider's age will be their current age on the day of event (proof of age may be requested).
14. Height Certificates are not required for this event.
15. All competitors must pay the helper fee, and provide a helper or self-help, to be refunded the helper fee.
16. Competitors are to compete in **SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY**, No martingales allowed and whips are to be a maximum length of 70cm. Leading Rein must have the lead attached to the noseband.
17. Competitors competing in Lead Line must stay on lead in all events.
18. **Competitors competing in WALK/TROT that are seen to be cantering around the grounds will be asked to move to WALK/TROT/CANTER.**
19. The PH&PC reserves the right to interpret all rules & make a decision where any dispute arises.
20. Maximum of 3 dressage tests per rider & horse combination either same level or 1 level higher and riders must ride at the level either they, or their horses' are eligible for. .
21. In the event that two tests are ridden at the same level, only the first test ridden will be counted towards any placings. Only 1 rider may ride a horse on any day. Dressage rules as per EA Australia, but specific show rules or PH&PC related rules take precedence.
22. Boots, bandages and bell boots may be worn during warm up but must be removed before being gear checked and entering your test.
23. Dressage draw will be emailed to all competitors before the event.
24. **Horses and/or riders deemed to be competing at an unsuitable level by the organizing committee may not have their entries accepted**
25. Pre Entry Only. Refunds will only be given to competitors with a Vet or Doctors Certificate dated prior to or on the last day of competition. PH&PC (Inc.) reserves the right to cancel/modify the event without prior notice as they see fit.
26. The organizing committee of the Perth Horse and Pony Club Inc., judges, officials, DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the 'Waiver of Liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.

Christmas Carnival Information

- This event will be run as a round-robin with competitors competing as horse/pony/rider combinations.
- Compete in 4 of the 6 sections to be eligible for high point awards.
- This event will be scored and placed from 1st – 6th in each ring and age group.
- Accumulated high score award will be announced at the end of competition. Prizes for High point and Runner up.
- Prizes for the best use of the tinsel theme in your or your horses attire. *(Must be safe for you and your horse! And other horses from a visual perspective)*
- Dressage will commence at 8.00am.
- Other rings will commence at 8.30am.

DRESSAGE

Dressage tests will be Prep E, Preliminary 1B and Novice 2C. A draw will be available.

ENGLISH EQUITATION

This is basically a show horse (hacking) class. English Equitation is judged on the horse & rider. The rider's effect on the horse and the horses responsiveness while executing a set workout. The class is ridden individually and scored. The workout will be set by the judge on the day. Scoresheets will be available at the completion of the day.

HUNTER JUMPER

This class is basically a working hunter class that combines the flat and jumping elements.

The horse and rider are judged on their ability to complete a set workout that includes 4 small jumps. This class is ridden individually and scored. The workout and judging criteria will be available prior to the day.

HANDY PONY TRAIL

This class will involve negotiating a small course including carrying an object from one point to another, Getting off and leading your horse, Walking over poles and backing your horse etc.

This is a timed event.

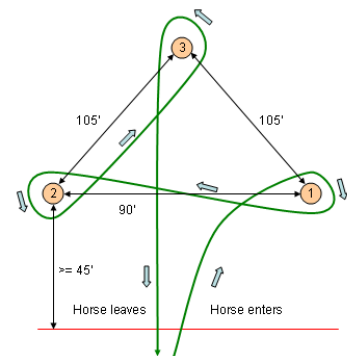
BARREL RACE

This has three barrels set up in a triangular pattern and each rider must turn each barrel in a clover leaf pattern as fast as they can. Riders must cross their track (see Diagram of a Barrel Racing Course).

Riders enter at the red line, circle around the 1st barrel, proceed to the 2nd barrel, and then continue on to the 3rd where they will complete the pattern and finally exit the course crossing the red line a second time.

This pattern is often referred to as a "Cloverleaf". The pattern may also begin with the left barrel first.

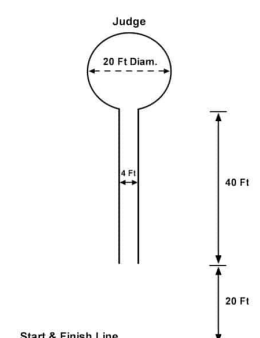
This is a timed event.



KEYHOLE RACE

The Keyhole pattern is to be run in between four poles. Contestants run between the poles to the marked circle and turn around (may turn around either direction) and run back through the same four poles to the finish line.
