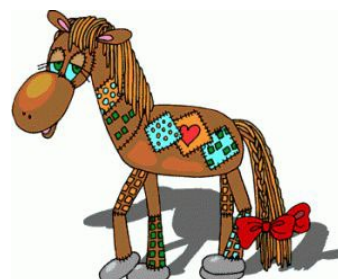
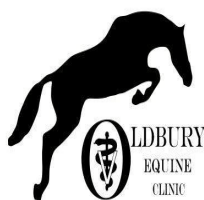

SHOWMAN SERIES 2022
DRESSAGE/SHOWJUMPING/IN-HAND

- Competitors must attend at least 2 of the 3 events to qualify for the series
- Only the same horse rider combination can carry forward and points earned
- Age of rider is at the 1st of January 2022
- If horse rider combination goes up a grade, they may take ½ the points earned from previous event to count for the series. Horse rider combination may only change a grade at the second event to still qualify for the series. Points cannot be taken down a grade.
- In the event of riders having equal points after the 3rd series the winner will be decided on the highest dressage score for the last event both riders entered.

Point awarded as follows for individual disciplines at each event

- 1st 7 points
- 2nd 5 points
- 3rd 4 points
- 4th 3 points
- 5th 2 points
- 6th 1 point

Points awarded as follows for the series placing in each event

- 1st 8 points
- 2nd 6 points
- 3rd 5 points
- 4th 4 points
- 5th 3 points
- 6th 2 points
- Completion 1 point

LEAD REIN DRESSAGE TEST

Collective marks:

General Impression	Rider & Pony make a suitable combination. Rider relaxed, at ease. Pony obedient, willing to obey all transitions.	10	
Position of Seat	Good posture – shoulder, hip, heel in a line. Soft elbows. Looking forward at all times. Weight even into both stirrups.	10	
Leg Position	Long quiet leg, heels lowest point. Inside lower leg touching pony sides. Stirrup on ball of foot. Legs squeezing not kicking.	10	
Hand Position	Holding reins correctly. Quiet hands, not dependent on reins for balance. Hands are on either side of the pony's neck, one fist apart. Hands squeezing not pulling.	10	
Effectiveness of back, seat, leg and hand aids	Correct use of these aids will produce a forward, obedient pony.	10
