RULES SHOWMAN SERIES 2022 DRESSAGE/SHOWJUMPING/IN-HAND

- Competitors must attend at least 2 of the 3 events to qualify for the series
- Only the same horse rider combination can carry forward and points earned
- Age of rider is at the 1st of January 2022
- If horse rider combination goes up a grade, they may take ½ the points earned from previous event to count for the series. Horse rider combination may only change a grade at the second event to still qualify for the series. Points cannot be taken down a grade.
- In the event of riders having equal points after the 3_{rd} series the winner will be decided on the highest dressage score for the last event both riders entered.

2nd 5 points

3rd 4 points

4th 3 points

5th 2 points

6th 1 point
