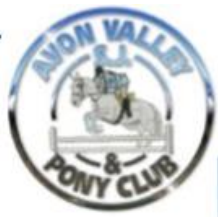

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COVID19

Please note that the committee are keeping up to date with the current COVID19 Guidelines and the most up to date information will be posted closer to the event via our Facebook Page.

Anyone feeling unwell or is a close contact to a confirmed COVID19 case is unable to attend the event.

Competitors that test positive to COVID19 or have to quarantine due to being a close contact in the lead up to the event are to contact the Event Secretary. A refund will be available to all those competitors that can not attend due to COVID19 less 10%* for administration fees.

Should the committee need to cancel the event due to COVID19, a refund will be processed, less 10%* for administration fees.

*10% refund will be processed for those that paid via Direct Deposit, entries paid via PayPal will be less 15% in administration fees.

MULTIPLE HORSES: Limit of 2 horses per rider, both horses may be entered in the same class, substitutions are permitted before the start of the event if accompanied by a veterinary certificate and the replacement mount is eligible under the Pony Club WA rules.

COMPULSORY HELPERS: All riders to provide a helper over the age of 16, job preferences considered but not guaranteed. Limited self-help only available with prior consent, please contact Event Secretary. Those with helpers will be given preference if classes are full. No self-help for riders with 2 horses.

STARTING TIMES: Draw & Helper duties will be available in the reports on www.ktrials.com.au prior to the event.

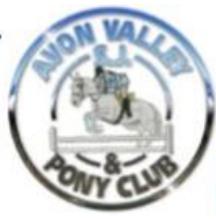
TECHNICAL DELEGATE: Deb Ware

VETERINARIAN: On call Saturday and On grounds for Sunday

FIRST AID: St John Ambulance will be in attendance Saturday and Sunday

CANTEEN/MEALS: Canteen open Saturday morning until dressage & Showjumping is finished. Canteen open on Sunday morning early to end of event.

MEDICAL POLICY: All active participants (riders, competitors, officials, helpers etc.) are strongly advised to have on them or have with an accompanying adult, up to date information regarding current or previous medical conditions which could require treatment in the future or affect their treatment in serious accidents (eg: allergies, previous head injuries etc.)



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AWARDS: Prize giving will take place unmounted in correct dress Code (see below) in the club house at the conclusion of the day. Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place. Completion ribbons will be awarded for riders completing the event without elimination in PC65 and PC45 classes. Other prizes may be awarded, depending upon sponsorship.

WITHDRAWALS: Can be made by the competitor via Ktrials online system up until closing. Refunds after event entry has closed will be given at the discretion of organizers only if a vet or doctor's certificate is supplied within 1 week after the event.

CAMPING: Available Saturday night cost of \$10 per family.

Dress & Saddlery – Refer Appendix IV in Pony Club WA Eventing Rules 2020 NOTE: No Dress & Saddlery Check before each phase = NO START.

All riders must wear a body protector for XC phase and riders are encouraged to wear one for the Show Jump phase.

No helmet cameras of any description are permitted.

Riders must wear a Medical Armband for the XC Phase.

Riders must provide an A4 number holder bib & bridle number for their competitor number.

RIDERS AGE:

PC 105 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 13.

PC 95 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 12.

PC 80 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 11.

PC 65 & PC 45 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 9.

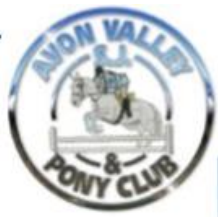
HORSES AGE:

A horse may compete in PC45, PC65, PC80, PC 95 & PC105 competitions from the beginning of calendar year in which it turns 5 years.

NOTE: The onus is on the owner/rider to provide proof of horses age.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Current Pony Club WA cards must be shown before picking up rider number.
- Riders in Open Classes must be a minimum age of 18 as at 1st January 2021. All open riders must have Pony Club WA insurance and present their card or receipt before being able to pick up their rider number.
- Riders weighing 53kg or more may not ride ponies 12.2h or under in a pony club activity.
- Compulsory helper details must include address of helper to be forwarded to Pony Club WA for insurance purposes.
- No rider under the age of 18 is to be left on the grounds without a parent/guardian.
- No colts or stallions are allowed to compete.
- No Dogs are allowed on Avon Valley SJ & PC grounds – Those that bring a dog will be asked to leave.
- All Hay & manure is to be placed in manure pits located at the grounds or taken with you.



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Pony Club WA STATE EVENTING LEADER BOARD: This is a separate leader board maintained by Pony Club WA head office.
