You agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by you to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of your participation in the activities and your immediate removal from your horse no matter where that may occur. You understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability as a result of your failure to comply.

- It is the exhibitor/rider/handler's responsibility to be aware of and abide by all rules set out in each of the above-mentioned documents.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

- a) All exhibitors lodging an entry into any West Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc. (WAAHA) event/s shall accept and be bound by these rules upon entering the event.
- b) Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with all rules and guidelines listed or referred to in this document. It remains the full responsibility of the owner / handler / rider to comply with the equipment rules and general rules as outlined.
- c) Breach of the rules may entail elimination unless other penalties are stipulated.

ASSOCIATION LIABILITY

The West Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc (WAAHA) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person or animal by reason of any defect, accident, natural disaster, negligence, or neglect however arising.

Entry to the event is done with the exhibitor/participants knowledge that a pandemic named Covid-19 is still active in Australia and neither The Affiliate, The AHSa Ltd. or the Show Committee will be held liable for any Covid-19 related incident that may occur as a result of participation. All current government restrictions in place at the time of event will be adhered too.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries into events are to be submitted via methods listed in the show schedule and must be accompanied by the correct payment and all supporting documents by close of entries.
- Incorrect and/or incomplete entries that have not been finalised by close of entries will not be accepted. Exhibitors will be sent only one email requesting any outstanding documents, monies etc be forwarded to the show committee.
- Exhibitors must include the names of all persons attending the event as a handler, rider or groom on their entry form.
- By lodging an entry, the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms & conditions of the event. The signature on an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same.
- Payment plans are available to all exhibitors when entering. 3 equal payments are to be made on or before the dates stipulated on the entry form. The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure payments are made on time. The committee WILL NOT send out reminders when payment is due. If final payment is not received on or before close of entries the entries will not be accepted.

REGISTRATION, OWNERSHIP & MEMBERSHIP

- All horses must be registered or Performance Index recorded with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited. Horses may only compete in classes for the section of the registry in which they hold registration.
- The Society does NOT recognise any form of "pending" registration and horses without a registration or recording number must not be exhibited.
- Persons exhibiting any horse, Purebred, Derivative or Performance Index, must be the Registered Owner or Lessee as per the Certificate of Registration or Recording.
- **Owners or Lessees of any Arabian, any Arabian Derivative or any Performance Index exhibit MUST be current financial members of the AHSa Ltd in order to be eligible to show at an event conducted by AHSa Ltd or any AHSa Ltd Affiliate in classes for Arabian and Arabian bred exhibits.**
- **Participants/Riders/Handlers who are not the registered owner of the exhibit (or any horse registered or recorded with The AHSa Ltd) may be AHSa Ltd Participant Members.**
- **All Exhibitors, Riders and Handlers must be current members of AHSa to compete.**

WAAHA MEMBERS RATES

- Only current 2022 Junior, General, Family/Joint and Life members of the WAAHA Inc., whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter at WAAHA member's rates.
- Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries.
- Non-members of WAAHA competing in Rider/Handler classes must pay non-member rates for those classes regardless of the horse owner's membership status.

PERTH POLO CLUB (KINGS MEADOW) – CONDITIONS OF USE

- **ALL MANURE, HAY AND RUBBISH MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE GROUNDS BY THE EXHIBITOR.**

Do not leave any manure/hay piled around trees or bags full of rubbish/manure/hay on the grounds, IT MUST ALL BE REMOVED BY THE EXHIBITOR.

- Ensure any holes dug by horses are filled in prior to leaving.
- Camping is welcome – the toilets and shower will be available for use. There are no powered sites or permanent yards, exhibitors will need to provide their power source and own safe yards if they are camping (must be attached to the float and made of solid panels - no electric only fencing). There is to be no camping near the river. There are wash bays and hoses available for use.

- ALL MANURE AND RUBBISH MUST BE REMOVED BY EXHIBITORS. No manure, rubbish or waste, bagged or otherwise is to be left at the grounds.

REFUNDS

Refunds after the close of entries will only be considered by the show committee where

- application in writing is made to the committee before the commencement of the event outlining the reasons for withdrawal.
- a valid doctors or veterinarian certificate must accompany the above request for the exhibitor / exhibit in question.

If approved, a refund of 50% of class entry fees will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Non-attendance at an event, an exhibit missing a class or being disqualified are not grounds for a refund.

In the case of an exhibitor being required, by law, to self-isolate or be in quarantine due to COVID-19 risk or exposure, a full refund will be provided upon proof of such legal requirement.

STALLIONS

At all WAAHA events, exhibitors, handlers and riders of stallions will be required to abide by the rules set out in the EA Stallion Safe Practice Rules & Regulations Policy - [https://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA Stallion Safe Practice Policy 15062018 0.pdf](https://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA%20Stallion%20Safe%20Practice%20Policy%2015062018%200.pdf)

Whilst it may not always be possible for green stallion discs to be attached to some in-hand cable halters, it is strongly recommended they be worn in all halter classes.

All stallions will be issued with a green exhibit number which must be worn by the handler / rider in all classes.

APPROVED SAFETY HELMET

Any person mounted on a horse is required to wear an approved safety helmet with the retaining harness secured and fastened at all times, in ANY class. Protective headgear must conform with current standards as per Equestrian Australia General Regulations at rule 122.2.

EXHIBIT NUMBERS

Where entries have been allocated an exhibit number, the exhibit or handler/rider/driver must display the correct exhibit number at all times in each event unless otherwise permitted by a show official.

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES

Any horse with a current Annual or Life Height Certificate is to compete in the correct height classes. Due to the impact of COVID and no measuring being available at Kings Meadow, for this show, horses who do not have a current height certificate are to compete in the height class of their estimated height. Horses two years and under are to compete in height class of their expected mature height. A copy of the height certificate must be provided with the show entries where applicable.

CLASS RULES

SHOWHORSE / SHOW HUNTER / PERFORMANCE HORSE CLASSES

Horses may compete in Showhorse, Show Hunter or Performance Horse classes. Horses may not compete in more than one section. If a horse is competing in halter and ridden, they must compete in the same section in both halter and ridden classes.

- **Showhorse Class** - Horses will be judged on their suitability as a led / ridden Showhorse.
Halter - Horses are to be presented as for Showhorse classes in a full English/show bridle or cable halter.
Ridden – Horse and riders are to be presented as for Showhorse classes.
- **Show Hunter Class** - Horses will be judged on their suitability as a Show Hunter.
Halter - Horses are to be presented in hand in a full English Show Hunter bridle (no ribbon browbands or cable halters)
Ridden – Horses and riders are to be presented as they would for Show Hunter classes.
- **Performance Horse Class** – Horses will be judged on their suitability as a Dressage, Jumping/Eventing or Endurance horse.
Halter - Horses are to be presented in hand as they would for the discipline they represent. Dressage, Jumping and Event horses in a full English bridle (no ribbon browbands or cable halters). Endurance horses in a headcollar / halter (as for vetting at an endurance ride)
Ridden - Dressage horses and riders are to wear a dressage bridle (no ribbon browbands) and a white dressage saddle cloth as per dressage competition rules.
Jumping / Event horses and riders to present as per dressage horses or in jumping saddle / tack (no martingales or boots allowed).
Endurance horses and riders to be presented neat and tidy as they would for a Best Conditioned Award (no boots or martingales allowed.) If Endurance riders are riding in a non-heeled shoe (runners) they must have a caged stirrup.

BROODMARE CLASSES *See AHSA Rulebook Section 3.15 for the full definition of a Broodmare*

A mare may compete in a brood mare or open mare class but not in both at the same show. A mare competing in a Broodmare class or a mare with a foal at foot may not exhibit in any performance event.

NON-PRO CLASSES *See AHSA Rulebook Section 16 for the full definition of a Non-Pro*

Competitors competing in Non-Pro classes must complete a Non-Pro Declaration form at each event they attend to declare their Non-Pro status.

YOUTH CLASSES *See AHSA Rule 19 for full definition*

- Handler classes - Are open to all competitors aged four to seventeen years.
- Ridden classes - Are open to all competitors aged five to seventeen years.

Due to the Youth of the Year award, the youth's age will be taken from the 1st January in the year of competition.

Birth certificates will be required for proof of age.

LEADLINE CLASSES See AHSA Rule 19.2 for full details

Riders must be three to seven years old. Handler must be 18 years or older. Leadline riders cannot compete in any other ridden classes.

YOUNG HORSE CLASSES

For horses aged between 3 and 5 years irrespective of if they have previously competed under saddle. Horses must be ridden in a snaffle bridle.

DUAL REGISTERED

Horses competing in Dual Registered classes must be registered with AHSA and another recognised Breed or Colour Society. Proof of second registration must be provided with show entries where applicable.

ENDURANCE HORSE CLASSES See AHSA Rulebook Section 21 for full definition.

All horses must be registered with AHSA and in possession of an official Open Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA) Endurance horse Log Book and be currently registered with AERA either annually or life. (Current registration and logbook to be produced if required).

THE ULTIMATE ARABIAN

Judged at the All Arabian Show. Open to all Purebred Arabians and Arabian Derivatives.

Qualification

A horse must compete and place in their halter breed (classes 1-6 and 8–85) and ridden breed (classes 170 – 190) to qualify to compete in the Ultimate class. A breed class is a mare, stallion or gelding class that is not restricted by handler or rider age or status.

Judging

The class is conducted in two parts.

- Part 1 - Exhibits are presented to the judge(s) under saddle where a ridden workout is completed and each exhibit is given a score out of 10 (one being the lowest score and ten being the highest).
- Part 2 - Exhibits are presented to the judge(s) in halter and each exhibit is given a score out of 10 (one being the lowest score and ten being the highest).

Scoring

The led and ridden parts of the class are each worth 50%. The points from both parts of the class are combined and the highest score wins. Ties are split by the higher halter score.

Judges

One or two judges may be used. If one judge is used (one judge for Part A and one judge for Part B) the score is out of 20, and if two are used (both judge Part A and Part B) the score is out of 40.

Handler/Rider

There must only be one rider and one handler per horse. These may be the same person, or two people. There should be no more than two individuals in the ring at any one time.

Presentation of winner

Horses to be saddled at the completion of the class for presentations.

Places awarded will be gold, silver and bronze for first, second and third respectively.

There is no restriction on the number of times an exhibit can win this class, providing that it enters and contests the class in accordance with the rules.

Committee reserves the right to modify the way this class is judged on the day if the situation dictates.

Definition of a Non-Pro

A non-pro is one who, regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, in the past three years has not directly or indirectly accepted as payment, goods or money for services usually provided by a professional in the areas of breaking, riding, training, schooling, driving, halter preparation, showing in halter or under saddle.

The following activities shall not affect the Non-Pro status of a person who is otherwise qualified;

- a) The writing of books
- b) Accepting remuneration for judging or stewarding
- c) Speaking at workshops, clinics, seminars or training days in a voluntary capacity where they do not accept a fee for their services.
- d) Receiving prize money or goods as services.
- e) Having the occupation of farrier, veterinarian, stable hand or groom.
- f) Owning or operating a saddlery, stud or breeding farm or boarding stables.

Spouses and immediate family of a trainer are also able to be registered as a Non-Pro, providing they are not involved with any of the above listed activities with horses where the trainer is being paid.
